6.0 DIRECTIVE:

Mr. Speaker urged the Chairmen of Committees handling various Bills to expedite action on them.

7.0 PERSONAL EXPLANATION:

Hon. S.O. Ajanaku (Ibadan South-West II) drew the attention of the House to a broadcast in Channels television on the continuous closure of Ladoke Akintola University Technology (LAUTECH), Ogbomoso. He passionately appealed for immediate intervention of the two Executive Governors of Oyo and Osun States respectively; Senator Abiola Ajimobi and Ogbeni Rauf Aregbesola, to end the incessant crisis (particularly in the area of payment of Salary and Allowances) so as to pave way for the re-opening of the Institution. He equally called for the meeting of the two Legislative Houses in the two States so as to brainstorm on the way out of the crisis. Mr. Speaker appealed for intervention of all Stakeholders with a view to finding immediate medium and long term solution to the crisis of LAUTECH.

Mr. Speaker sued for peace so as to enable the two owner States find a lasting solution to the crisis. He said the Institution may not be re-opened if the crisis persists.

8.0 SECOND READING OF LADOKE AKINTOLA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, OGBOMOSO (AMENDMENT) BILL 2016

Motion made and question proposed that a Bill for a Law to Amend Ladoke Akintola University of Technology, Ogbomoso Law, 1990 be Read a Second Time – Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan south-West I), Majority Leader.

Bill accordingly read a Second Time and referred to Committee on Education, Science and Technology for further consideration.
