(b) They were put on Oath and thereafter, made individual presentations of their Curriculum Vitae. Thereafter, they fielded questions from Honourable Members.

(i) **Abimbola Adekanmbi**

He hailed from Ona-Ara Local Government of Oyo State. He had his Secondary School Education at Orita-Mefa Baptist Model College before proceeding to Obafemi Awolowo University where he obtained his first degree in Accounting. He also has B.Sc. Applied Account from Oxford Brooks University U.K and MBA in Strategy and Finance, Liverpool John Moores University, U.K. He held various positions in the Private Sector before he was appointed Deputy Chief of Staff during the First tenure of His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi between 200.11 - 2015. He responded to question put to him and subsequently found appointable.

(ii) **Atinuke Silifat Osunkoya** hails from Ibadan North Local Government of Oyo State. She started her primary education at Carona School, Apapa, Lagos and her secondary education at

Methodist Girls' High School, Yaba, Lagos. Thereafter, she proceeded to University of Lagos for her First Degree. She served as a Banking Officer with Guaranty Trust Bank between 1992 – 1996 and as Project Finance Officer with British Council, Nigeria between 1997 – 2011. She was appointed as Commissioner for Women Affairs between 2011 and 2015 in Oyo State. The House took cognizance of her laudable antecedent and therefore, found her appointable.

- (iii) **Mr. Kolade Daniel Abimbola** was born on 11th August, 1968 and hails from Fiditi in Afijio Local Government of Oyo State. He obtained Bachelor of Science Degree in Building from Obafemi Awolowo University and Masters Degree in Housing from University of Ibadan. He started his career as Assistant Contract Administrator, with Tower Building Products, Lagos, where he rose to the post of Sales and Marketing Manager. He served as Commissioner in Oyo State between 2011 and 2015. He was considered to be a loyal political office holder who served meritoriously. He was found appointable.
- (iv) **Princess Taibat Adeyemi Agaba** was born to the Royal Family of His Imperial Majesty, Oba Olayiwola Adeyemi, the Alaafin of Oyo on 7th September 1969. She started her Primary School, Education at Abiodun Atiba Primary School, Oyo before proceeding to Palm Middle School, Culver City California she obtained her First Degree in Sociology from University of Ilorin in Kwara State. She worked with Falibar Royal International Ltd Consultant, Ibadan. Her royal background was considered respectable. She was found appointable.
- (v) **Barr. Oyewumi, Oyewole Kazeem** was born on 25th November, 1961 to the Rooyal Family of the Soun of Ogbomoso. He started his Primary Education at Holy Trinity Primary School, Kano, proceeded to Ogbomoso Grammar School for his Secondary Education and University of Ife (now Obafemi Awolowo University) where he obtained his first Degree in English (Drama). He obtained his Bachelor of Law Degree from University of Jos and also attended, The Nigerian Law School Lagos where he qualified as Barrister at Law. He started his political career as an elected councilor at Apapa Local Government area of Lagos state and later become the Vice Chairman of the same Local Government. He had also served in several capacities as a member of All Progressive Congress. He was

considered to be a complete gentleman with attractive resume in spite of his royal origin. He was found appointable.

- (vi) **Barr. Abayomi Akinkunmi Oke** hails from Ogbomoso North Local Government of Oyo State. He had his Secondary education at the Government College, Ibadan between from 1979 to 1984 subsequently proceeded to the University of North London, Holloway where he obtained a Bachelor of Law degree. He also attended the Nigerian Law School where he qualified as a Barrister of Law. He served as Special Adviser on Environment to the Governor of Oyo State between August 2011 and May 2015. He was described to be a very polite and unassuming personality. He worked diligently with His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi (during his first term). He was found appointable.
- (vii) **Alhaji Dauda Oladimeji Wasiu** hails from Iseyin, in Iseyin Local Government Area of Oyo State. He started his education at A.U.D. Primary School, Ebedi, Iseyin. He obtained Bachelor of Education in (Mathematics) and Master in (Business Administration) from the University of Ilorin. He worked with the Local Government Service Commission, Oyo State between 1994 and 1998. He served as an elected councilor in Iseyin Local Government and also as a Commissioner between August, 2011 and September, 2013. He was found to be a committed political office holder who served assiduously in the Cabinet of His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi during his first term. He was found appointable.
- (viii) **Mr. Isaac Ajiboye Omodewu** hails from Out, Itesiwaju Local Government. He obtained his First School Leaving Certificate in 1975 and General Certificate of Education (O/L) in 1986. He also obtained a National Diploma in Accountancy from Yaba College of Technology and Master Degree (Business Administration) from Obafemi Awolowo University Il-Ife in 2014. He started his career as Account Associate with Nigeria National Petroleum Corporation in 1991. He also worked with Abisco Tyre and Auto incorporation, Queens, New York as Chief Financial officer. He served as Commissioner with the Government of Oyo State between 2011 and 2015. He was described to be loyal member of the Executive Council during the first term of Governor Abiola Ajimobi. He was found appointable.

- (ix) **Chief Isaac Adisa Ishola** hails from Saki in Saki West area of Oyo State. He attended L.A. Primary School, Olorunda, Ile-Ife between 1966 and 1970 for his Primary education and later St. John Cherubim/Seraphim Modern School, Ipetumodu, Osun State between 1971 and 1974. He obtained a Bachelor of Science Degree in Economics from University of Lagos in 1986, Postgraduate Diploma in (Computer Science) from Obafemi Awolowo University Ile-Ife in 1991 and Master of Science Degree in Finance from University of Calabar in 2002. He retired as Director, Finance and Accounts in December 2013 from National Examination Council. (NECO) and has since engaged himself as a farmer. He was found to be a grassroots mobilizer, philanthropist and a man with broad experience. He was a community developer. He was found appointed.
- (x) **Mr. Abdul Ganiyu, Mohammed Mudathir Bamidele** was born on 20th February, 1959 in Igbeti in Olorunsogo Local Government. He had his Primary Education at Festival Primary School, Kano between 1966 and 1972 and later proceeded to Lautai Government Secondary School, Gumal, Jigawa State for his Secondary education. He obtained Bachelor of Arts Degree in Mass Communication in 1983 from Bayero University, Kano and Master of Science Degree in Mass Communication from University of Lagos in 1992. He also obtained various Professional certificates and also a member of various professional bodies. He has served in various capacities as lecturer, media practitioner and administrator before his nomination, he was the Chief Executive Officer of Emgee Publishing Limited, Ibadan. He has vast experience in human public relations. He was found appointable.
- (xi) **Toye Adeola Arulogun** He hails from Village in Akinyele Local Government Area of State. He graduated from University of Ibadan, with second class upper Division in Theater Arts, in 1986. His Professional Career spreads across various organizations in the Theatre industry. He was appointed Senior Special Assistant (Public Relations) to the Oyo State Governor in July 2011. He also served as Special Adviser to the Oyo State Governor (Public Affairs) from January 2012 till May, 2015. Members judging from his antecedents and brilliant presentation, discovered that he has what it takes to hold any public office. He was found appointable.

- (xii) **Oluseun Mobolaji Abimbola** He was born in Lagos on 21st June, 1971. He hails from Ibadan South West Local Government area of Oyo State. He had his University Education at the Obafemi Awolowo University where he obtained his First Degree in Law in 1992. He had his Masters Degree from the same University in 2007. He held position in various organisations in his area of specialty is an author of three publications and holder of numerous awards. He was described as a Legal icon, a quintessential party loyalist and enviable team player. He was found appointable.
- (xiii) **Professor Joseph Adeniyi Olowofela**
He hails from Omi-Adio in Ido Local Government area of Oyo State. He had his first degree in 1986 in Physics from the University of Ibadan and Second Degree in 1988 also in Physics (Solid Earth). He obtained his PH.D in Physics (Solid Earth Geophysics) also from Ibadan. He had served in various positions in both public and private sectors before he was appointed as Chairman, Ido Local Government from August 2011 to December, 2014. He was a seasoned academician. Going through his resume and presentation, he was found to be a man of integrity and consequently found appointable.
- (xiv) **Dr. Azeez Adewolu Popoola Adeduntan:**
He hails from Olupoyi Compound, Oja Oba in Ibadan South West Local Government Area of Oyo State. He had his first degree in Health Sciences from the University of Ife now Obafemi Awolowo University and Second Degree from Harvard, Boston Massachusetts, U.S.A. He had been awarded various honours and prizes in Nigeria and United States of America, He is an accomplished Medical Practitioner, a good team player, a man of uncommon intellect. He was found to have a rich history of integrity and consequently found appointable.
- (xv) **Mr. Fatai Adesina Salau** was born on 6th October, 1973 in Ibarapa North Local Government. He had his Secondary Education in Ayete Grammar School, Ayete. He later proceeded to St. Andrew's College of Education, Oyo. He obtained BA.(Ed) in History from the University of Ado Ekiti. He was the Caretaker Chairman, Ibarapa North Local Government between 2012 and 2014. He also served as a Senior Special Assistant to the Governor of Oyo State between February to May, 2015. He was found to be a good party man and subsequently found appointable.
