4.0 MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE:

Mr. Speaker read the contents of under-listed letters authored by His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi

- (i) titled "Request For Budget Re-alignment in the Provision of the 2016 Approved Budget to the Oyo State House of Assembly" with Reference No. MFB/B/42/11 dated 14th December, 2016. The letter sought the approval of the House that the sum of Three Billion, Six Hundred and Ninety Million, Four Hundred and Eighty-Three Thousand, Five Hundred and Thirty Two Naira, Thirty-Three Kobo (₦3,690,483.532.33) be moved from the unutilized budgetary provision in IPSAS Codes 46010102 and 23020102 to take care of the inadequacies of budgetary provision to mobilise for the award of contracts for the underlisted road projects:
 - (a) Dualisation of Idi-Ape-Basorun-Akobo-Odogbo Barracks Junction (7.0km);

- (b) Dualisation of Saki Township road from Oke-Ogun Poly – Ilesha Ibariba Road;
 - (c) Dualisation of Agodi-Old-Ife Road-Adegbayi (7.3km) with limited rehabilitation of spurto Alakia Ibadan Airport;
 - (d) Expansion of Oke-Adu-Agodi-Idi-Ape-Iwo Road interchange (3.2km)
 - (e) Reconstruction of Eleyele-Akufo Junction (7km) with spot rehabilitation to Eruwa (51km).
- (ii) 67th Birthday Anniversary dated 8th December, 2016. (a) **Citation Of Master Babalola, David Oluwasayo**

Hon. A. Musah (Saki West), Deputy Speaker presented his citation. Master David Oluwasayo Babalola hails from Saki, in Saki West Local Government and was born to the Family of Jonathan Oyebamiji and Olufunmilayo Ayobami Babalola on Friday, April, 30, 1999. He attended University of Ibadan Staff School, University of Ibadan for his primary education. He was thereafter, admitted to Oritamefa Baptist Model School, Total Garden, Ibadan, after coming first in the Common Entrance Examination among over a thousand prospective candidates. He had several awards and laurels to his credit, among which were the awards from Young Writers Club, United Kingdom for an article he wrote on Nigeria, "I have a Dream", Cowbell National Secondary Schools Mathematics Competitions at National Level for Junior and Secondary Categories among others. He was admitted as a Medical Student at the University of Ibadan after obtaining nine A1s in WASSCE, 2015, and has maintained a GPA of 7.0 out of 7.0. His extra curricula activities included; playing chess, and music. He had also participated actively in Student Press Organisations.

(b) **Members Comments:**

Members commented glowingly on the achievements of Master David Oluwasayo Babalola and prayed vehemently for his continued success in his academic career. They also eulogized the Parent and the School Management for their unprecedented supports to Master David Babalola. - (v) urge the Transition Committee Chairman, Atiba Local Government to patch the service roads within and around Sabo Market to enable free traffic as interim measure.
