5.0 **MATTERS OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE**

Pursuant to order VIII 4 (1-4) of the Standing rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. S.A. Olalere (Ido) raised A Matter of Urgent Public Importance on the Need to Urgently Repair Damaged Drainages Along Alafara/NIHORT/Elenusonso Road in Ido Local Government Area.

By leave of Mr. Speaker, the matter was referred to the Committee on Works and Transport which was directed to undertake an inspection visit to the place and report to the House.

**6.0 COMMITTEE REPORT:**

Pursuant to the Directive of the House on Thursday, 12<sup>th</sup> November, the House receive the Report of Ad-hoc Committee on the State of LAUTECH Teaching Hospital, Ogbomoso as presented by the Chairman, Hon. S.O. Ajanaku (Ibadan South-West II), Chairman Parliamentary Council.

Motion made, "that the Report as presented be adopted for debate" – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South West I), Majority Leader

Motion seconded by Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba), Party Whip, L.P

Question put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

**Resolved** as follows, "that the

Executive Arm of Government should,

- (i) appoint a new Chief Medical Director to run the administration of Ladoke Akintola University of Technology Hospital, Ogbomoso as soon as possible;
- (ii) set necessary machinery in motion for the completion of infrastructure and installation of equipment in the Teaching Hospital. Funds should also be made available to contractors with outstanding payment certificates to enable them complete the following:
  - (a) magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI);
  - (b) construction of all shafts for the installation of elevators;
  - (c) provision of 3 phase power supply to energise the College of Medicine and House Officers' quarters;
  - (d) completion of the construction of LAUTECH Teaching Hospital Outreach Centre, Oyo with a view of putting it into immediate use and also the uncompleted projects in LAUTECH Teaching Hospital, Ogbomoso;
- (iii) release funds for the completion of the dedicated Dam which is about ninety percent (90%) completed for the benefit of the Teaching Hospital and the host Community;
- (iv) constitute the Board of Ladoke Akintola University of Technology Teaching Hospital, Ogbomoso; and
- (v) commend the staffers of the Teaching Hospital, Ogbomosho that were instrumental to certain developmental activities e.g. donation of books to the Library, Completion, Furnishing

- of buildings, purchase and installation of medical equipment e.t.c. for their good gestures; and
- (vi) the Committee on Health should be mandated to take up the assignment of monitoring of all construction and installation works and ensure that the contractors follow laid down plans in the schedules towards the completion of projects.

**7.0 Need To Split The Thirty-Three (33) Local Government Areas Into Local Council Development Authorities For Effective Grassroot Development**

Motion made, "that this Honourable House take critical look at the present structure of Local Government Administration in the State which has not effectively brought about the desired development with a view to initiating the splitting of each of the thirty-three (33) Local Government Areas into two or three Local Council Development Authorities – Hon. P.O. Oyetunji (Ogo-Oluwa/Surulere)

Motion seconded by Hon. M.A. Wahab, (Oluyole)

Title of Motion was amended thus:

"Need to Establish Local Council Development Areas for Effective Grassroot Development:
