7.0 **COMMITTEE REPORT:**

House received Report of the Ad-Hoc Committee that carried out on-the-spot assessment of the Fire Outbreak at Bola Ige International Business Complex (BIIBCO), New Gbagi, Ibadan with a view to condoling with the affected traders as presented by the Chairman, Hon. A. Musah (Saki-West), Deputy Speaker

Motion made "That the House do receive the Report as presented for debate" – Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J.O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Debate arising.

**Resolved** as follows, "that

- (i) the Executive Arm of Government be urged to put in place a collaborative effort between the Ministries of Trade, Investment and Cooperative, Lands, Housing and Physical Planning and Environment and Water Resources to evacuate illegal structures

and traders from access road, open spaces, motor parks and around public buildings within and around the Business complex;

- (ii) the State Emergency Management Agency (SEMA) should as a matter of urgency provide relief materials to ameliorate their losses of the affected traders;
- (iii) the Executive Arm of Government be urged to provide new Service Vehicle to the Fire Services Station in-charge of the Complex to make the Station more effective and also attend to other problems encountered by the Station;
- (iv) the relevant Committee of the House should always monitor the activities of the Task force charged with the Management of the Complex to ensure compliance with the Master Plan of the Complex in such a way that facilities such as access roads, motor parks, open spaces, fire station, drainages, generator house, setbacks e.t.c. are not distorted;
- (v) the Executive Arm of Government should as a matter of Urgency put machinery in motion for the establishment of another Business Complex to decongest Bola Ige International Business complex, Gbagi, Ibadan; and
- (vi) the Executive Arm of Government through the Ministry of Trade, Investment and Cooperative should direct the facility Manager to ensure that all new structures under construction in the Complex are put on hold till further notice"

#### 8.0 **NEED TO URGENTLY ADDRESS GROSS INDISCIPLINE IN SCHOOLS AND RESTORE SANITY IN THE EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM IN OYO STATE**

The mover of the Motion - Hon. Silas Adeleke Okunlola (Iwajowa) sought Mr. Speaker's consent and approval to defer the Motion till another legislative day. The Motion was deferred till another Legislative day.

9.0 **REVIEWING THE JOINT OWNERSHIP OF LADOKE AKINTOLA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY: A STEP TOWARDS SOLE OWNERSHIP BY OYO STATE GOVERNMENT.**

Motion made "That this Honourable House deliberate on ways and means of disengaging Osun State from Ownership of the Ladoke Akintola University of Technology (LAUTECH) in view of the failure of Osun State Gvoernment to fulfill its financial obligations to (LAUTECH) Ladoke Akintola University of Technology, Ogbomoso – Hon. B.O. Oladeji (Ogbomoso North), Hon. P.O. Oyetunji (Surulere/Ogo-Oluwa), Hon. A. Musah (Saki-West), Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Hon. A.A. Oladipo (Ibadan North-West), Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba), Hon. R.A. Jimoh (Ibarapa North & Central), Hon. A.F. Adesina (Ibadan South-East I), Hon. A.A. Adeleke (Iseyin/Itesiwaju) and Hon. L.O. Balogun (Oorelope) – Co-Sponsor.

Motion seconded by Hon. A.F. Adesina (Ibadan South-East I)

Question that the Motion be debated put and agreed to.
