Motion made, "That the Votes and Proceedings of Thursday, 7th June, 2016 be adopted as amended" – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. G.J. Oyekola, (Atiba), Party Whip LP
Question put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly in the affirmative.

4.0 **RECOGNITION OF VISITORS:**

Mr. Speaker recognized the presence of The Secretary of All Progressive Congress (APC) Hon. M.A. Olaoya, former Member of this Honourable House who was at the gallery to watch the House proceedings.

5.0 **ANNOUNCEMENT:**

Mr. Speaker announced that the Committee on Health would be meeting after the day's Plenary Sitting in the Conference Room.

6.0 **CORRESPONDENCE:**

Mr. Speaker read the contents of the following letters:

I Condolence letters from:

- II Ibadan Elders Forum, dated 26th June, 2016 and titled "RESOLUTION OF EDUCATIONAL CRISIS IN OYO STATE"
The forum urged the House to consider Legislation for bidding the use of children in protest rallies in future and application of appropriate sanctions to sponsors who violate the legislation
- III A correspondence dated 26th July, 2016 titled "FUELLING ISSUE PROGRAM ON OUR RADIO STATIONS, WAY OUT!" from Mr. Olusegun Omotanbaje Akinwale
The author drew the attention of the House to the practice of broadcasters who translate newspapers review into Yoruba on radio stations in their reporting attitudes. He alleged superfluous reportage which could mislead listeners. He therefore, urge the House to take necessary step to curb such practice and charge broadcaster to abide by the tenets of their profession.
- IV A letter dated 25th July, 2016 titled "URGENT ATTENTION ON STATE SECURITY MATTERS AND OTHERS"
from Pastor Akande Lawrence Olasunkanmi. The author is seeking for urgent attention of the House to be drawn to incessant immigration of male youths from the northern part of the country into the State for security purposes.

7.0 **DIRECTIVE:**

Mr. Speaker directed that Commissioner of Police, Oyo State Command and other Security outfit in the State should step up their intelligence gathering towards apprehending the killers of Hon. Gideon Aremu, who was gruesomely murdered on Friday, 1st July, 2016.

8.0 MATTER OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:

- (a) Pursuant to Order VIII Rule 4 (1) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon S.O. Oguntade (Egbeda) raised a matter of Urgent Public Importance on the Need to Prevent Further Fire Outbreak and other Emergency Situation at New Gbagi Business Complex.

He therefore, moved that Government take preventive measures to forestal future occurrence at the Complex.

Motion seconded by K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I)

- (b) Motion made "That Order 8 Rule 4 (3) be suspended to enable the Matter of Urgent Importance be debated - Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly as follows: "That:

- (i) the Executive Arm of Government should establish taskforce that would see to the restructuring of the Gbagi Market in order to ensure and enforce compliance with the Original Master Plan of the Business Complex;
- (ii) the State Emergency Management Agency (SEMA) should provide relief materials to the victims;
- (iii) the Executive Arm of Government through the State Fire Services, should upgrade New Gbagi Fire Service Station;
- (iv) the Ad-Committee comprising the underlisted Members should do on-the-spot assessment of the situation within the Complex and condole with the affected traders and report back to the House:

- (d) Pursuant to Order VIII Rule 4(4) of The Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly another Matter of Urgent Public Importance was raised on "Curbing the Menace of Neighbourhood Cultism and Campus Cultism) – Hon. O.O. Olaleye (Ibadan North II) He therefore, made a Motion that the House implore the Executive Arm of Government, security Outfits, School Managements and other stakeholders to take proactive and urgent measures to prevent the activities of the cultists in the communities.

Motion seconded by HonA. Musah (Saki West), Deputy Speaker.

Motion made, "that the Matter of Urgent Public Importance be taken - Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I) – Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. G.J. Oyekola, (Atiba), Party Whip LP

Question put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

Resolved: accordingly as follows: That

- (i) The Executive Arm of Government through the Ministry of Information, Culture and Tourism should embark on Sensitisation and Orientation Programmes of Cults Members in the affected communities like Agbowo and Tertiary Institutions in the State;
- (ii) The Nigeria Police and other Law Enforcement Agencies in the State should help in the arrest and presecution of all cults members involved in the deaths of rival cults members and innocent citizens;
- (iii) the Management of both University of Ibadan, The Polytechnic, Ibadan, Landlords' Association and all Stakeholders in the affected communities, to embark on Joint Programmed of actions that will help in stemming the tide of neighbourhood and campus cultism;
- (iv) all Oyo State citizens and residents to always help the laws enforcements agencies and police with adequate information that can lead to the arrest and prosecution of the cult members who engage in killing, fighting, robbery, raping and other dangerous activities; and
- (v) the Executive Arm of Government to come up with a Security Master Plan, to stem the tide of cultism and its resultants effects in our environment.

The Clerk of the House read the Administration of Criminal Justice Bill, 2016 for the **FIRST TIME**

10.0 THIRD READING OF OYO STATE TERTIARY INSTITUTIONS STAFF RETIREMENT AGE BILL, 2016

- (i) House received the Report of the Joint Committee on Education, Science and Technology, Establishment, Training and Poverty Alleviation that considered Tertiary Institutions Staff Retirement Age Bill, 2016 as presented by the Chairmen, Hon. Afeez A. Adeleke (Iseyin/itesiwaju) and Hon. B.A. Azeez (Ona-Ara)

Motion made, "that the Report as presented be adopted for debate" - Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I) – Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. G.J. Oyekola, (Atiba), Party Whip LP

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly in the affirmative.

IN THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE HOUSE:

Long Title: Question, that Long Title stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 1: Question, that Clause 1 stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 2: Amendment to the interpretation thus: that

(i) after the word "Sciences" the words "and Technology" be inserted in line 7, and

(ii) after the newly inserted "Technology" the words "College of Nursing and Midwifery" be inserted

Question, that Clause 2 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 3: Question, that Clause 3 stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 4: Amendment proposed that a new Clause 4 be inserted to read thus: that

"Any Circular, direction, notice or document issued or deemed to be issued in this regard that was in force before the commencement of this law shall be deemed to have been commenced under this law.

Question, that a new Clause 4 be inserted and stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 5: Amendment proposed to Clause 5 as follows, That:

- (i) former Clause 4 become Clause 5 and Sub-Clause 5(i) be deleted and replaced with "Any person who alters his age or the age of any other person through any act of commission or omission, for the purpose of benefiting under this bill is guilty of an offence", and
- (ii) Sub-Clause 5(ii) be deleted and replaced with "Any person who knowingly or negligently contravenes sub-clause (i) shall be liable on conviction to a fine of Five Hundred Thousand Naira (N500,000.00) or to imprisonment for a term of 5 years or both.

Question, that Clause 5 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Mr. Speaker resumed his seat, Bill reported, read the THIRDTIME and passed
