6.0 **URGENT NEED FOR REVIEW OF STATE CONSTITUENCIES DELINEATION IN OYO STATE**

Motion made "That this Honourable House do deliberate on the over bloated nature of some State Constituencies in the State and the need for upward review by the Independent National Electoral Commission as contained in the 1999 Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria (As Amended)" - Hon. Abdul Ganiyu Oseni (Irepo/Olorunsogo)

Motion seconded by Hon. R.A. Jimoh (Ibarapa North)

Question that the Motion be debated put and agreed to.

The title of the Motion was amended thus: "Urgent Need For Implementation Of State Constituencies Delineation In Oyo State
Debate Arising.

- (i) The Executive Arm of Government through the Ministry of Justice be implored to make a formal request to the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC), for an upward review of the State Constituencies, to a total of Forty (40) Constituencies;

- (ii) the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC), be implore to take proactive measures and give effects to the judgement of the Federal High Court on the upward review of the State Constituencies; and
- (iii) Honourable Members representing Oyo State at the House of Representatives and Oyo State Senators at the National Assembly be implored to put in Legislative actions and necessary logistics at the National level to ensure implementation of the judgement of Federal High Court on the upward review of the State Constituencies”.

NEED FOR OYO STATE INDEPENDENT ELECTORAL COMMISSION TO KICK START THE PROCESS FOR THE CONDUCT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTION IN THE STATE

Motion made “That this Honourable House critically examine the activities of the State Independent Electoral Commission, especially the performance of the Board since it was constituted in June, 2016, with a view to ascertaining its level of preparedness for the Local Government Election in the State” – Hon. O.A. Oyatokun (Afijio), Deputy Majority Leader and Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. S.O. Ajanaku, (Ibadan South West II), Chairman, Parliamentary Council.
