Motion made and question proposed that a Bill for a Law to Establish the Agency for Disability Affairs, to Safeguard People Living with Disability Against all forms of discrimination and Equalise Their Opportunities in all Aspects of Living in the Society and for Connected Purposes be Read a Second Time - Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan south-West I), Majority Leader.

8.0 NEED TO URGENTLY STOP HAWKING OF CUTLASSES IN OPEN LOCATIONS SUCH AS MOTOR PARKS AND ROADSIDE

Motion made "that this Honourable House deliberate on the act of free hawking of cutlasses in open locations and the attendant

dangers associated with such practice with a view to correcting it” – Hon. J.O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. Oyebamiji (Akinyele I)

Question that the Motion be taken put and agreed to.

Amendment made on the title of the Motion to read thus: “Need to Urgently Stop Hawking of Cutlasses and Other Dangerous Weapons in Open Locations such as Motor Parks, Roadside and other Unauthorized Places”.

Debate Arising:

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly as follows: “that

- (i) the Commissioner of Police and other Security Operatives put a stop to hawking of Cutlasses, particularly by the Roadside and Motor Parks and restrict sale of Cutlasses to Shops, Markets and other Unauthorized locations; and
- (ii) Relevant security agencies be empowered to seize and confiscate all cutlasses on sale by the Motor Parks and other unauthorized places.
