Pursuant to Order VIII 4(1 – 4) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South West I) raised a Matter of Urgent Public Importance on "Urgent Need to Stem the Incessant Gang Violence Around Foko, Born-Photo, Isale-Osi and Kudeti Axis, Ibadan and Oyo State at Large".

6.0 **FIRST READING OF OYO STATE INFRASTRUCTURE MAINTENANCE AND CONTROL AGENCY BILL, 2016**

The Clerk of the House read the Oyo State Infrastructure Maintenance and Control Agency Bill, 2016 for the **FIRST TIME**.

7.0 **COMMITTEE REPORT:**

House received the Report of the Ad-Hoc Committee that scrutinized Steps Being Taken To Discourage Indiscriminate Erection Of Kiosks, Containers, Shops And Other Unathorised Commercial Activities Which Are Not Education And Learning Friendly Within And Around Public Schools In Oyo State” as presented by Hon. P.O. Oyetunji (Surulere/Ogo-Oluwa), Chairman

Motion made, “that the Report as presented by the Chairman, Ad-hoc Committee be adopted for deliberation” – Hon. K.H. Subair, (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba).

Question put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

Question that the recommendations be adopted put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly thus: “that:

- (i) the Ministry of Education should be commended for its proactive steps taken to issue circular informing all School Administrators as advised by the Committee to remove all the temporary structures such as Kiosks, Mobile Containers and Shanties within and around Schools. This step has started

- yielding positive result in the course of the assignment before the Committee;
- (ii) the Ministry of Education, State Universal Basic Education (SUBEB) in collaboration with the Ministry of Lands, Housing and Physical Planning should re-establish; beacons/corner pieces and ensure fencing or public Schools with hallow blocks, wall fence or trees planting;
 - (iii) the Executive Arm of Government through the Ministries of Education, Lands, Housing and Physical Planning should complete all process leading to the proper acquisition of public schools land;
 - (iv) the Executive Arm of Government through the Ministry of Lands, Housing and Physical Planning and Office of Surveyor-General should resuscitate the Inter-Ministerial Committee on Schools' land encroachment to conclude perimeter survey-plan of public Schools in the State;
 - (v) the Ministry of Education should see to the immediate removal of kiosks and containers abutting the fences of Baptist Grammar School, Baptist High School, Masifa D.C. Primary School, and Anglican Grammar School, Ogbomoso;
 - (vi) the Ministry of Education should henceforth react promptly to any report of encroachment reported by the School administrators;
 - (vii) the Ministry should henceforth submit School development Proposal (both Public and Private) to the Ministry of Lands, housing and Physical Planning for approval.
 - (viii) the Oluyole Local Government should release Open Market Stalls located within the Schools premises at Community Basic Primary School, Kolomi, Odo-Ona Elewe to State Universal Basic Education Board (SUBEB) for conversion of classrooms;
 - (ix) the Landlords and Owners of all residential buildings at Community Basic Primary School, Kolomi, Odo-Ona Elewe should be apprised to fulfill their obligations as agreed upon, i.e. construction of fence and toilets for the School in the interest of peaceful co-existence;
 - (x) the Ministry of Lands, Housing and physical Planning and SUBEB should monitor the proposed fence to be constructed by owners of Residential buildings at Community Basic Primary School, Kolomi, Odo-Ona Elewe in tandem with original survey plan produced by property owners (Messrs. Oshinowo and Adegbite);

- (xi) the Ministries of Education, Land, Housing and Physical Planning as well as State Universal Basic Education Board (SUBEB) should take urgent step to communicate Globacom and MTN Communication Network to remove their masts erected in Baptist Primary School, Ago-Are, Atisbo Local Government;
- (xii) the Corporate bodies and Members of the Public should be urged to desist from encroaching on School's land for whatever reason; and
- (xiii) all Government Institutions especially the Local Government in the State should get approval from the Ministry of Education before construction of any public buildings on School's land".
