## 3.0 **APPROVAL OF VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS:**

Mr. Speaker announced that he had examined the Votes and Proceedings of Thursday, 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 and called for comments.

Motion made, "That the Votes and Proceedings of Thursday, 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 be adopted" – Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

**Resolved:** accordingly in the affirmative.

## 4.0 **PRIVILEGES:**

Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba) raised A Matter of Privilege under Order V of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly. He drew the attention of the House to the list of Chairmen, Caretaker Committees of Local Government Councils and Local Council Development Areas which the House deliberated upon at the last Sitting. He observed:

- (i) that Contrary to the Resolution of the House two of the proposed Chairmen found unapponintable (that is, Asabari LCDA and Irepo LG. C) the Executive Arm of Government went ahead and sworn them in;
- (ii) that proposed Chairman of Lagelu West Local Council Development Area (Akeem Aransi) whose appointment was confirmed by the House was not sworn-in, rather his name was substituted with that of Abiodun Oladeji.

The House consequently resolved as follows:

- (1) That the following Government Officials be invited to appear before the Committee on Ethic and Privileges:

- (a) Secretary to the State Government;
  - (b) Commissioner for Local Government and Chieftaincy Matters; and
  - (c) The Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Local Government and Chieftaincy Matters.
- (2) That nobody should parade himself/herself as Chairman, Caretaker Committees of:
- (i) Asabari LCDA;
  - (ii) Irepo Local Government Council; and
  - (iii) Lagelu West Local Council Development Area.
- That anybody caught doing so shall be arrested by the Police.
- (3) That Mr. Akeem Aransi remains cleared as the Chairman nominee for Lagelu West LCDA and that the status quo remains; and
- (4) The Committee on Ethics and Privileges should investigate the matter and report within two weeks.

#### 5.0 **MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE:**

Mr. Speaker read the contents of a letter received from the Office of the Executive Governor titled “Re: Confirmation of Caretaker Chairmen for Local Government and Local Council Development Areas”, Ref. No. Gov. 2017/05/82 dated 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2017.

By leave of the House, the letter was stepped down till the House received the Report of the Committee on Ethics and Privileges on the subject matter.

#### 6.0 **ANNOUNCEMENT:**

Mr. Speaker made the following announcement “that:

- (iii) Committee on Health meeting with Private Medical Practitioners in the State after Sitting; and
- (iv) Committee on Education meeting with the Officers of the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology after Sitting to consider the Technical University, Ibadan Bill, 2017”.

#### 7.0 **MATTERS OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:**

Pursuant to Order VIII (4) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. S.A. Okunlola (Iwajowa) raised a Matter of Urgent Public Importance on the Meningitis Epidemic in Some Parts of the Country and the alleged two (2) reported cases at Ojoo, Ibadan which was later debunked. He expressed the view that the Executive take preventive measures to avoid same experience in the State.

Mr. Speaker directed Committee on Health to interact with the Ministry of Health on the matter and report to the House.

## 8.0 APPEARANCE BEFORE THE HOUSE

Pursuant to the Resolution of the House on Tuesday, 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2017, the following Government Officials appeared before the House:

- (i) Mr. Adebisi Oloko, Special Adviser to the Governor on Revenue Matters;
- (ii) Mr. Isaac Ajiboye Omodewu, Commissioner for Lands, Housing and Urban Development; and
- (iii) Mr. Babatunde Oladipo, Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Lands, Housing and Urban Development.

Mr. Speaker informed the House that Mr. Abimbola Adekanmbi, Commissioner for Finance and Budget took permission to attend to his health.

By leave of the House, the appearance was re-scheduled to another Legislative day to enable the invitees to brief the House on measures being taken to meet their revenue target for year 2017.

## 9.0 COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- (i) House received the Report of the Committee on Education, Science and Technology on her engagement with the Ministry of Education in ascertaining the current status of the teaching of History as a Subject in Public Secondary Schools in the State as presented by the Chairman, Hon. Afeez A. Adeleke (Iseyin/Itesiwaju).

Motion made, "that the Report as presented be adopted for debate" – Hon. K.H. Subair, (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J.O. Ojo (Oriire).

Question put and agreed to.

**Resolved:** accordingly as follows:

- (i) the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology should mandate the School Administrators to encourage Historical and cultural societies as part of the extra-curricular activities for students to learn more about their historical and cultural background;
- (ii) the Teaching Service Commission should appoint Guidance Counselors in Schools in Oyo State in order to sensitize the Student on importance of History as a subject;
- (iii) the Teaching Service Commission (TESCOM) should encourage appointment of graduate History teachers and organize seminars for all existing History teachers for them to be acquainted with the best method of teaching the subject.

**10.0 SUSPENSION OF ORDER IV (1):**

Motion made “that Order IV (1) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly be suspended to enable the House sit beyond 1.00 p.m. this day” - Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.
