6.0. NEED TO PROVIDE MODERN AGRICULTURAL STORAGE SYSTEM SO AS TO ENSURE FOOD SECURITY IN OYO STATE

“That this Honourable House take critical look at the necessity and importance of construction of modern Silos to store agricultural produce in the State with a view to ensuring food sustainability and regular supply throughout the year” – Hon. O.A. Oyatokun (Afijio), Deputy Chief whip.

Motion seconded by Hon. J.A. Olalelru (Kajola), Deputy Chief Whip.

Question that the Motion be debated put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly as follows:

That the Executive Arm of Government be urged to:

- (i) expedite action on the completion of the Oyo multimillion naira Silos;
- (ii) further put machinery in place to construct modern Silos in Oke-Ogun, Ibarapa, Ogbomoso zones;
- (iii) provide moderate agro-processing facilities in each of the geo-political zones of the State;
- (iv) set up Marketing Board that will buy from farmers during harvest for storage;
- (v) employ more Agricultural Extension Officers and post them to the various zones to enlighten farmers on the new mode of storage and processing of agricultural produce to minimize wastage;
- (vi) provide soft loans to real farmers for the construction of low-capacity storage system;
- (vii) mandate the Chairmen of Transition Committees of Local Government Councils and the Local Council Development Areas to embark on grading of rural roads to ease transportation of farm products;

7.0 NEED TO PUT AN END TO THE INCESSANT NIGHT ROBBERY ATTACKS ON INNOCENT CITIZENS WITHIN IBADAN METROPOLIS

Motion made, “that this Honourable House examine with serious concern the perpetual security threat unleashed on innocent citizens by Armed Robbers within Ibadan Metropolis over the last few months where many lives were lost and properties worth millions of naira carted away, with a view to taking measure that will put an end to the criminal activities and restore peace to the area” – Hon. A. Ige (Ibadan South-East II).

Motion seconded by Hon. B.S. Badmos (Akinyele II).

Question that the Motion be debated put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved accordingly as follows, that:

the Committee on Security, Functionaries of the House, Hon. A.A. Ige and other Honourable members representing Constituencies affected by the Matter under debate to meet with the under-listed to discuss remedial measures and report back to the House:

- (i) the Senior Special Assistant (SSA) to the Governor on Security Matters;
- (ii) the Commissioner of Police, Oyo State Command;
- (iii) the Director, State Security Service, Oyo State Directorate;
- (iv) the State Commandant, Nigerian Security and Civil Defence Corps;
- (v) the Executive Secretary, Oyo State Security Trust Fund; and
- (vi) other relevant Stakeholders.

8.0 **PRESENTATION OF REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC PETITIONS, HUMAN RIGHTS, ETHICS AND PRIVILEGES**

House received the report of the Committee on Public Petitions, Human Rights, Ethics and Privileges on its investigation into the erroneous swearing in by the Executive of three nominees as Chairmen, Transition Committee of Irepo Local Government Council, Asabari and Lagelu West Local Government Council Development Areas whose appointment were not confirmed by the House as presented by the Chairman, Hon. M.A. Olagunju (Oyo East/West).

Motion made, "That the House do receive the Report of the Committee on public Petition, Human Rights, Ethic and Privileges as presented by the Chairman" – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South West I)

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

Question that the recommendations be adopted put and agreed to.

Resolved accordingly as follows, "that:

- (i) the Executive Arm of Government should without any form of derogation respect and implement the Resolution of the House regarding the rejection of both Messrs Mudasiru Agbaje and Adeleke Taiwo and credible replacements should be forwarded accordingly for Irepo Local Government and Asabari Local Council Development Area respectively;
- (ii) while the Executive Arm has the right of nomination, the House of Assembly should resist any form of sharp practices on the part of the

Executive Arm as demonstrated in the Oath of Office taken by Abiodun Oladeji without being screened and approved by the House of Assembly consequently, the Oyo State House of Assembly should not legalize the appointment of Abiodun Oladeji under any guise. His nomination or any re-nomination should be discountenanced and rejected even as the Executive is at liberty to forward the name of a fresh nominee for Lagelu West Local Council Development Area;

- (iii) the Executive Arm of Government be urged to be gender-compliant pursuant to Section 42(1) of the 1999 Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria (As Amended) and Section 11 of the Local Government Law, 2001.
- (iv) the Oyo State House of Assembly should ensure that it remains resolute in its Constitutional duty to defend and uphold the Principle of Separation of Powers.
