4.0 ANNOUNCEMENT:

Mr. Speaker announced that the Ad-Hoc Committee on Electricity Disaster at Olomi Ibadan would meet after the Sitting in Room 110 of the old Building at 1.00pm.

5.0 MATTERS OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:

- (i) Pursuant to Order VIII Rule 4(1) of the Stading Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. (Mrs.) B. O. Oladeji (Ogbomoso North) raised a Matter of Urgent Public Importance titled “An Horrible Accident on the Damaged Portion of Oyo – Ogbomoso Road and the Need to Hasten construction of the Express way linking Oyo – Ogbomoso”. The matter was about the accident that claimed the lives of three Principals of Secondary Schools and a Bursar and the need to put in place measures to avert future occurrence.

Motion made,” that Order VIII Rule 4(3) of the Standing Rule of Oyo State House of Assembly be suspended to enable the House deliberate on the matter this day”- Hon A. F. Adesina (Ibadan South-East I).

Motion seconded by Hon. O. A. Oyatokun (Afijio) Deputy Majority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Debate Arising on the substantive motion.

Question put and agreed to

Resolved as follows “ that this Honourable House;

- (i) Commiserate with the families of the deceased,
- (ii) Urge the Executive Arm of Government through the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology;
 - (a) to as a matter of duty compensate the families of the deceased particularly by award of scholarship to the deceased’s children as well as taking care of the medical bills of those victims still in critical condition in the hospital,
 - (b) give priority attention and facilitate quick payment of the deceased entitlement to their families; and
 - (c) the Ministry of Health to establish a temporary emergency centre or place ambulances on strategic location along the road to give first aide treatment to accident victims before and on the way to the Hospital for comprehensive treatment.

- (iii) appeal to the Federal Ministry of Works, Power and Housing to mandate the FERMA to expedite action to fix the lay by and damaged portions of the road while work on the new express road should be completed as quickly as possible,
- (iv) appeal to the Presidency and Minister of Works, Power and Housing to hasten the construction of the Oyo-Ogbomoso new express way,
- (v) appeal to the Oyo State Sector Commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps to deploy more personnel to the road to caution drivers and sanction the erring ones, and
- (vi) appeal to National Union of Road Transport Workers (NURTW) and Road Transport Employers Association of Nigeria (RTEAN) to sensitize their members on the need to be cautious when plying the the road.

6.0 SCREENING OF NOMINEE FOR THE POSITION OF PRESIDENT OF CUSTOMARY COURT OF APPEAL, OYO STATE:

Pursuant to the Directive of the House on Tuesday, 23rd January, 2018, Justice Solomon Adegboyega Akinteye, nominee for the position of President of Customary, Court of Appeal, Oyo State appeared before the House for screening.

He was put an oath, afterwards he introduced himself to the House. He was born on the 23rd day of June, 1953 at Igboora, Ibarapa Central Local Government of Oyo State. He attended Methodist Primary School, Igboora between 1959 – 1967. He also attended Igboora High School Igboora, from 1966 – 1972. His Lordship obtained his Bachelor of Law, B. L (Hons) degree from the University of Ife, Ile-Ife 1980. He was called to the Bar in 1981 and did his National Youth Service (NYSC Corps) the same year. He also worked in several legal firms as a legal practitioner before he was appointed and sworn in as a Honourable Judge of the High Court of Justice, Oyo State on 30th days of January, 1997. His Lordships had undertaken several judicial assignments creditably. Members appreciated His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi on the nomination of a well experienced, diligent, learned, capable and balanced judge as a pioneer President of the State Customary Court of Appeal. The nominee was also described as a round peg in a round hole.
