Motion made “that the Report as presented be adopted for debate” – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly in the affirmative.

(ii) Motion made “that this House do constitute itself into the Committee of the Whole House to consider the Report, including recommendations of the Committee on Women Affairs and Community Development that considered Handicapped Bill, 2017 – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Question that Long Title as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 1: Amendment proposed as follows:

- (i) that Clause 41 become Clause 1 with “Short Title” as side note;
- (ii) delete “Handicapped” and replace with “Persons living with Disability”; and
- (iii) delete “2016” and replace with “2017”

Question that Clause 1 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 2: Amendment proposed that, Clause 40 become Clause 2 with “Interpretation” as side note.

Question that Clause 2 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 3: Amendmend proposed, that former Clause 1 become Clause 3 and delete the words “Disability Affairs” in Sub Clause 1 and replace with “Elimination of the Discrimination against Persons living with Disability”

Question that Clause 3 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 4: Amendment proposed that: former Clause 2 become Clause 4 and (i) in Sub – Clause (2) insert “Ministry of Women Affairs, Social Welfare, Community Development and Poverty Alleviation” as Sub Clause 2(a) and re – arrange other Sub–Clauses accordingly;

(ii) After Sub - clause 2(g) insert the following:-

“(2h) a Medical Practitioner from the Ministry of Health”;
and

(2i) Special Adviser on Disability Affairs”

Question that Clause 4 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 5: Amendment proposed that former Clause 3 become Clause 5 and delete the word “will” after “Agency” in line 1.

Clause 6: Amendment proposed that former Clause 4 become Clause 6 and delete the word “Agency” in line 1and insert “Office” after “hold” and insert “One” after “another” in sub Clause 2(a).

Question that Clause 6 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 26 Amendment proposed that former Clause 25 become Clause 26 and delete One Hundred Thousand Naira (₦100, 000.00)” and replace with “Ten thousand Naira (₦10, 000.00)” in Sub Clause 3.

Question that Clause 26 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 27 Amendment proposed that former Clause 26 become Clause 27 and to insert “or any other relevant Agency” after (“OPD”) in Sub Clause 4.

Question that Clause 27 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 28: Amendment proposed that former Clause 27 become Clause 28 and to delete “or” and insert coma after “Cruelty”, and also insert “or” after “in human” in Sub Clause 1(b)

Question that Clause 28 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 29: Amendment proposed that former Clause 28 become Clause 29 and

(i) On the side note, delete “Prohibition” and replace with “Provision”;

(ii) Sub-Clause (1) insert “as far as possible” after “shall”; and

(iii) Expunge Sub Clause 2(b).

Question that Clause 29 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 30: Amendment proposed that former Clause 29 become Clause 30 and :

- (i) Re – write the side note as follows:-

Provision of Facilities in Public, Commercial and Business Premises”;

- (ii) In Sub Clause (3) line 2, insert “temporary” after “such”;
- (iii) in Sub Clause (5) line (1) delete “five(5) years” and replace with “One (1) year” and insert “Commercial, business premises” after “public”;
- (iv) in Sub Clause 6, line 2 delete “building” and replace with “commercial and business premises”; and
- (v) in Sub Clause 7(b) line(1) delete “compliant” and replace with “complaint”

Question that Clause 30 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 31: Amendment proposed that former Clause 30 become Clause 31 and to add a new Sub Clause (4) to read thus: “Provided that the provisions of Clause 29 and 30 shall be duly communicated to all relevant public and private organizations”

Question that Clause 31 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 32: Amendment proposed that former Clause 31 become Clause 32 and to add a new Sub Clause (12) to read thus: “Any person in position of responsibility over a child with disability and found to contravene any provision of this section shall be liable to imprisonment of six months or a fine of ₦100, 000.00 or both”.

Question that Clause 32 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 33: Former Clause 32 become Clause 33 and stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 34: Amendment proposed that former Clause 33 become Clause 34 and to insert “who is an indigene of Oyo State” after “disability” in line 2, and also insert “owned by the Oyo State Government “after institutions” in Sub Clause (2)

Question that Clause 34 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 35: Amendment proposed that former Clause 34 become Clause 35 and;

- (i) in Sub Clause (4) line 2, delete “a fine” and insert “pay compensation”; and
- (ii) in Sub Clause 5, line 1, delete “employing up to one hundred (100) persons” after labour” and also in line 2, delete “1% and insert 5% after “at least”

Question that Clause 35 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 36: Amendment proposed that former Clause 35 become Clause 36 and in line 2, insert “not” after “shall” in Sub – Clause 3

Question that Clause 36 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 37: Former Clause 36 become Clause 37 and stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 38: Question that former Clause 37 become Clause 38 and stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 39: Question that former Clause 38 become Clause 39 and stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 40: Amendment proposed that former Clause 39 become Clause 40 and to delete “subject to the approval of the House of Assembly “after “may”

Question that Clause 40 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 41: Amendment proposed that a new Clause be inserted as thus: “any person, group or organization who commits a breach of any provisions of this Bill for which no specific penalty has been prescribed shall be liable on conviction to imprisonment for a term of six months or fine of ₦100,000.00 or both.

Question that Clause 41 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Motion made “that the Report as presented be adopted for debate” – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J.O OJo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly in the affirmative.

(ii) Motion made “that this House do constitute itself into the Committee of the Whole House to consider the Report, including recommendations of the Committee on Commerce and Cooperatives

Clause 1: Question that Clause 1 stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 2: Amendment proposed that Clause 2 be rearranged thus:

(i) In “Academic Board” insert “established in Clause 22 of this Bill” after “College”.

Insert new interpretation as follows:

(ii) “Academic Staff” means any person in the employment of the College engaged in teaching or research in the College and the term shall where the context permits include the Provost and the Deputy Provost of the College.

(iii) “academic year” means such period not exceeding twelve months as the academic board may from time to time designate;

(iv) “appropriate University or Polytechnic” means University or Polytechnic which the College is affiliated for purposes of academic moderation and quality control;

(v) “College” means the Oyo State College of Cooperatives and Entrepreneurship Studies established in Clause 3 of this Bill;

(vi) In “Commissioner” insert “or any person in charge of the affairs of the Ministry for the time being” after “Cooperatives”;

(vii) “Department” means an Academic Unit established by the Academic Board and approved by the Council;

(viii) In “function” insert “and duties” after “powers”

(ix) In “Governor” insert “of Nigeria” after “State”

(x) In ‘Ministry’ insert “Industry” after “Trade”.

(xi) “non-academic staff” means person in the employment of the college other than the academic staff, who hold administrative, professional or technical posts;

(xii) In “State” delete the word “Government of”

(xiii) “Student” means a person who has been registered during a current academic year for a certificate or

diploma course or such other qualifications of the College as may be approved by the Academic Board.

Question that Clause 2 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 3: Amendment proposed thus:

- (i) Delete “in Oyo” and replace with “of the” and Delete “of Nigeria”.

Question that Clause 3 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 4: Question that Clause 4 stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 5: Amendment proposed thus:

Sub-Clause C, be deleted and replace with “institute and award scholarships, exhibitions bursaries, medals, prizes, distinctions, awards and other titles”.

Question that Clause 5 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 6: Amendment proposed as follows:

- (i) Delete Sub-Clause 2(a) and insert “Course of instruction leading to certificate in Cooperatives/Entrepreneurship Studies and its equivalent in such specialties as may be determined from time to time by the college and approved by the Commissioner and the Board for Technical and Vocational Education”;
- (ii) Delete Sub-Clause 2(b) and insert “Such other courses of instruction related to the Cooperatives/ Entrepreneurship/ Business Studies Profession leading to the award of Ordinary and Higher National Diploma as may from time to time be determined by the College and approved by the Board for Technical and Vocational Education of Oyo State and the Commissioner”.

Question that Clause 6 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 7: Question that Clause 7 stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 8: Question that Clause 8 stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 9: Amendment proposed as thus:

- (i) In Sub-Clause ‘1b’ delete “Representatives of the following Ministry” and insert “the Permanent Secretary of the”;
- (ii) insert side note to read thus: “Composition of The Governing Council”;
- (iii) In Sub Clause 1(a) delete “on the recommendation of the Commissioner” after “Governor”; and

(iv) In Sub Clauses (i) (b) (I - iii) delete “the Permanent Secretary of the”.

Question that Clause 9 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 10: Question that Clause 10 stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 11: Amendment proposed thus:

(i) in Sub Clauses (c - f) delete
“have power to”;

(ii) in Sub Clause (f) delete “respectful” before “function” in line 2;
Question that Clause 11 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 12: Question that Clause 12 stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 13: Question that Clause 13 stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 14: Question that Clause 14 stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 15: Amendment proposed as follows:

(i) in Sub-Clause (2) line 1 insert “or other related field” after
“Administration”.

(ii) in Sub-Clause “4” line I, delete “or”

Question that Clause 15 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 16: Question that Clause 16 stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 17: Question that Clause 17 stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 18: Question that Clause 18 stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 19: Amendment proposed as follows:

(i) insert a new Clause 19 to read “There shall be a Director of Medical Services who shall be appointed by the Council and shall be responsible to the Provost for the operations in the Health Center of the College”; and

(ii) re-number subsequent Clauses accordingly:

Question that Clause 19 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 20: Question that former Clause 19 become Clause 20 and stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 21: Amendment proposed that former Clause 20 become Clause 21 and to read “The Academic and Non-Academic staff of the College other than the Principal Officers in Clauses 13,14,15,16,17, and 18 of this Bill shall be appointed in accordance with the State Civil Service Rules”.

Question that Clause 21 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 22: Amendment proposed that former Clause 21 become Clause 22 and to insert “and allowances” after “salary” in line 1.
Question that Clause 22 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 23: Amendment proposed that former Clause 22 become Clause 23 and to delete “including the coordination of the programme of studies in all the Campuses” after “programme” in line 4.
Question that Clause 23 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 24: Amendment proposed that former Clause 23 become Clause 24 and:

- (i) in Sub-Clause 1c after “University” insert “or Polytechnic”;
- (ii) insert a new Sub-Clause (If) and to read thus “the Registrar who shall be the Secretary”;
- (iii) in Sub Clause 2 line 2 after the word “absence” insert the word the Deputy Provost and in the absence” and
- (iv) in Sub-Clause 2 line 4 delete “who may be acting for the Principal” and replace with “appointed by the member present may preside”

Question that Clause 24 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 25: Amendment proposed that former Clause 24 become Clause 25 and:

- (i) in Sub-Clause (c) line 3, delete “Ministry” and replace with “Council”;
- (ii) in Sub-Clause 2(d) insert “National” before “Board” and after “Education” delete “of Nigeria” before “and”;
- (iii) in Sub-Clause 2(h) insert “National” before “Board” and after “Education” delete “of Nigeria” before “and”.
- (iv) Insert a new Sub-Clauses j – m and renumber former Sub-Clause “j” as “n” as follows:
 - (j) recommend to the council the award of scholarships and academic prizes to the Students of the College;
 - (k) make rules for the award of certificates of the College;
 - (l) establish, organize and control the College and the departments of the college and allocate responsibility for the different branches of learning;
 - (m) make arrangements for and convening conferences and seminars and the provisions of in-service training facilities for both academic and non-academic staff and

students of the College and any other person or group as may be approved by the Council; and
(n) delete "Ministry" and insert "Council".
Question that Clause 25 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 26: Amendment proposed that former Clause 25 become Clause 26 and:

- (i) in Sub-Clause (1) delete "held by the person presiding once every year on the first Saturday of December at the College or any other time that may be decided by the academic board and insert "fixed on days and time to be decided by the Governing Council on the recommendation of the academic board of the institution"; and
- (ii) in Sub-Clause 3 delete "for such summon".

Question that Clause 26 as amended stand Part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 27: insert a new Clause 27 to read thus:

"The Commissioner shall have power to make regulations for the carrying into effect the provisions of this Law".

Mr. Speaker resumed his seat, Bill reported, read the **THIRD TIME** and passed.
