## 1.0 **APPROVAL OF VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS:**

## 2.0 **ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

Mr. Speaker made the following announcement: that

- (i) His Excellency, the Executive Governor, Senator Abiola Ajimobi has forwarded the name of Mr. Sulaimon Olanrewaju as the nominee for the post of Caretaker Chairman, Oriire North Local Council Development Area omitted in the earlier list forwarded to the House;
- (ii) the Committee on Environment and Ecology would commence a working visit to some MDAs after Sitting;
- (iii) the Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources would meet after the day's Sitting; and
- (iv) the Committee on Commerce and Cooperatives would meet after the day's Sitting.

### 3.0 DIRECTIVES:

Mr. Speaker directed the Chairmen of Committees with outstanding assignments due for consideration at Plenary to expedite action on same.

### 4.0 PERSONAL EXPLANATION:

Hon. J.A. Olaleru (Kajola), Deputy Chief Whip drew the attention of the House to another remarkable and giant step taken by His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi who graciously approved through the Ministry of Health A – 2 week free medical check up for public and civil servants in the State.:

The exercise commenced on Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 and expected to end on Friday, 17<sup>th</sup> November, 2017. He noted that the management and staff of the Oyo State House of Assembly and the House Service Commission also benefited from the scheme.

The approval given by His Excellency he said was a clear indication of the genuine commitment of the Governor to improving health status of the entire work force. He concluded by commending the Governor on the laudable initiative and also urged civil and public servants in the State to take advantage of the laudable programme.

- (ii) and that the Executive Arm of the Oyo State Government through the Ministry of Local Government and Chieftaincy Matters should organize an induction training course for these Chairmen at an auspicious time.

## **9.0 NEED TO MANDATE THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTS AND LOCAL COUNCIL DEVELOPMENT AREAS IN OYO STATE TO ENGAGE IN REGULAR MAINTENANCE OF LOCAL ROADS FOR RAPID SOCIO-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THEIR DOMAINS**

Motion made, “that That this Honourable House take cognizance of deplorable state of grade ‘C’ roads in the State and the ineptitude of the Local Governments to regularly maintain the roads with a view to mandating them (Local Governments and Local Council Development Areas) to perform their constitutional functions of rural road maintenance for the over-all development of their domains” – Hon. M.A. Wahab (Oluyole) and J. Oyebamiji (Akinyele I).

Motion seconded by Hon. A. Oseni (Irepo/Olorunsogo).

Question that the Motion be taken put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

Question put and agreed to.

**Resolved** accordingly as follows: “that

- (i) the Executive Arm of government through the Ministry of Local Government and Chieftaincy Matters issue directives to the Chairmen of Local Government and Local Council Development Areas by promptly giving due approval for them to take road maintenance as priority in order to accelerate good roads network at local level;
- (ii) the Directors of Works Department in the respective Local Governments and Local Council Development Areas in the State be alive to their responsibility by regularly engaging in the maintenance of local roads in order to boost socio-economic development in the State; and
- (iii) the Executive Governor to passionately consider rural communities by earmarking some amount of money for the rural Local Governments to fix bad roads in their various rural areas as is been done in the urban areas”.

## **10.0 NEED TO ADDRESS ACUTE SHORTAGE OF TEACHERS IN PUBLIC PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN RURAL AREAS OF OYO STATE**

Motion made, “That this Honourable House critically examine the inadequacy of teaching staff in Public Primary and Secondary Schools in rural areas of the State and its adverse effect on the education system with a view to advising the Executive Arm to take necessary steps to provide teaching staff for schools in the rural areas” – Hon. J.O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. (Mrs.) B.O. Oladeji (Ogbomoso North).

Question that the Motion be taken put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

Question put and agreed to.

**Resolved** accordingly as follows, “that

the Executive Arm of the Government through the Teaching Service Commission (TESCOM) and State Universal Basic Education Board (SUBEB) urgently:

- (i) carry out staff auditing in schools located in rural areas with a view to ascertaining the present deplorable condition of staffing of the said schools;
- (ii) embark on recruitment of qualified teachers as fresh intakes into the teaching service who will not refuse to be posted to any location – rural or urban or lobby for posting;
- (iii) monitor posting of teachers to all parts of the State with a view to ensuring even distribution of available teaching staff to all schools both in urban and rural areas;
- (iv) put in place and speedily implement a permanent package of incentives for teachers posted to any school located in any community in the rural areas of the State;
- (v) reintroduce Voluntary Teaching Service Scheme in order to fill the cacum created in the teaching service; and
- (vi) conduct recruitment of teachers at Zonal Offices of TESCOM and SUBEB in order to prevent rural-urban drift of Teachers in the State”.
