## 5.0 **MATTER OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:**

Pursuant to Order VIII Rule 4(1-4) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. M.A. Sangodipe (Atisbo/Saki East) raised a Matter of Urgent Public Importance titled "Need to Give Support to the Victims of properties destroyed by rainstorm In Irawo Owode, Ago-Are, Tede and Baasi in Atisbo Local Government". The matter raised was in respect of unpleasant incidence of rainstorm that wrecked havoc in Atisbo Local Government Area on Saturday, 7<sup>th</sup> and Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 respectively.

By Mr. Speaker's order;

- (i) the Clerk of the House was directed to write State Emergency Management Authority (SEMA) to take necessary steps towards

- providing relief material to the victims of the rainstorm in Irawo Owode, Tede, Ago-Are and Baasi in Atisbo Local Government; and
- (ii) the Transition Committee Chairman, Atisbo Local Government should take statistics of all victims of rainstorm of Saturday, 7<sup>th</sup> April and Monday 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 in the Local Government with a view to providing Temporary Shelters and relief items to those affected as palliative measure.
  - (iii) the Committee on Special Duties should follow up on the activities of (SEMA) in respect of the Matter and report to the House in two weeks.

#### 6.0 **SECOND READING OF LIVESTOCK OPEN REARING AND GRAZING REGULATION BILL, 2017**

Motion made and question proposed that “A Bill For A Law To Prohibit Open Rearing And Grazing Of Livestock And Provide For The Regulation Of The Activities Of Herdsmen And For Purposes Connected Therewith be read a **SECOND TIME**” - Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I) Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire) Minority Leader.

Bill accordingly read the **Second Time** and referred to a Joint Committee on Security and Strategy, Judiciary and Justice and Agriculture and Natural Resources for further scrutiny and report to the House.

#### 7.0 **PRESENTATION OF REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT, CHIEFTAINCY MATTERS AND STATE HONOURS**

The Report Of the Committee On Local Government, Chieftaincy Matters and State Honours that enquired into the causes of unused lockup shops and open market stalls constructed by some Local Governments in the State and means of activating them was presented by Hon. B.S. Badmos (Akinyele II) Chairman. Motion made, “that the House do adopt the Report of the Committee on Local Government, Chieftaincy Matters and State Honours as presented for debate” - Hon. K.H Subair (Ibadan SouthWestI), MajorityLeader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to

Debate arising.

Question that the recommendations be adopted put and agreed to.

**Resolved:** accordingly as follows, “that:

- (iii) the Authorities at the Local Government Councils (LG) and Local Council Development Areas (LCDAs) should endeavor to engage the members of

- the communities (i.e the end users) in the conception, processing, execution and utilization of public utilities in their domains;
- (iv) the Authorities at Ibadan South Local Council Development Area (LCDA) and Ido Local Government Council (LG) should negotiate for alternative dispute resolution on the neighborhood market at Bode and the Open Market at Apete to allow traders occupy the market and generate more revenue;
  - (v) the approving authority should consider the request with a view to granting approval for the renovation of Eleekara Express Shopping Complex in Afijio Local Government Area;
  - (vi) the Authorities at Ibarapa-East Local Government and Ibarapa North-East Local Council Development Area should give reasonable concession to interested traders to occupy Temidire Open Stall and Okolo Market. They should also find other use for Aniko Market which location was reported to be unsuitable; and
  - (vii) the Local Government Councils and the Local Council Development Areas who were still having unoccupied utilities should as a matter of necessity put necessary machinery in motion to ensure that the utilities are put to judicious use”.
