Motion seconded by Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba), L.P. Whip.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved accordingly in the affirmative.

4.0 ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Mr. Speaker announced that,

- (i) the Planning Committees for the 2017 Christmas Programme of the Christian Legislators Fellowship Internation, Oyo State Chapter would meet after the day's Plenary Sitting; and
- (i) the Rt. Hon. Speaker, some Hon. Members and staff would be attending A 2-day Workshop on "Developing Capacity of Lawmakers for Universal Health Coverage (UHC) between Thursday, 14th – Friday, 15th December, 2017 at Premier Hotel, Mokola Hill, Ibadan. The organisers are Legislative Network For Universal Health Coverage in partnership with other International and Development Partners.

5.0 FIRST READING OF BILLS:

The Clerk of the House read the underlisted Bills for the **FIRST TIME.**

- (iv) Oyo State Bureau of Investment Promotion and Public Private Partnership, Bill, 2017.

6.0 COMMITTEE REPORTS:

The Report of Committee on Security and Strategy that met with Stakeholders on the Cause(s) of Public Brawl at Isale-Osi, Iyana Asuni, Born Photo Area was presented by Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba), Chairman. Motion made “that the House do adopt the Report as presented for debate” – Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. A.F. Adesina (Ibadan South East I).

Debate arising.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved accordingly as follows that:

- (i) the political office holders (elected and appointed) at State and Federal levels from Ibadan South-West Local Government be urged to be more involve in the development of these areas, especially through provision of more empowerment programmes and rehabilitation of these boys;
- (ii) the Executive Arm of Government be urged to approve the deployment of two Operation Burst Patrol Vehicles, with more Officers and Operational tools to be patrolling these neighbourhood twenty-four hours to re-assure residents of their security and safety without further delay;
- (iii) the Executive Arm of the Government through the Bureau of Physical Planning and Development Control should come out with a new lay-out plan that would decongest the area to eradicate slums and make the neighbourhoods more accessible to modern development;
- (iv) the Executive Arm of the Government through the Ministry of Women Affairs, Community Development and Social Welfare build up synergy with Vigilante Groups/Landlords/Landladies/Residents Associations in Ibadan South-West Local Government to give effects to Section 4(3)(a) –(f) of Mobilisation of Community Committees Law of 1987 (as amended) which provides as follows, that:

- (a) all tenants and landlords must be registered within a ward;
- (b) there should be Landlords/Residents' Association;
- (c) the Association must keep a register of movement of residents within the wards;
- (d) the Association must monitor a register of guards within the wards;
- (e) the Association must monitor the movement of strangers within the ward and people with sudden wealth;
- (v) the Authority of Ibadan South-West Local Government be urged to set machinery in motion to compensate those that lost their properties due to the Sunday, 22nd October, 2017, deadly mayhem at Iyan-Asuni, Oremeji and Isale Osi area”.
- (vi) the Nigeria Police, Oyo State Command should intensify efforts to bring to book all the masterminds of Sunday, 22nd October, 2017 Violent attack on the residents and business operators at Iyana Asuni, Born Photo and Isale Osi axis of Ibadan South-West Local Government that led to loss of millions of naira in properties and other valuables;
- (vii) the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA), Oyo State Command should deploy more of their officers to Iyana-Asuni, Gidarami, Born-Photo, Isale- Osi, Foko, Gege and Ita Barika area in Ibadan South West Local Government Council with a view to clamp down on the operators of over five hundred indian hemp and other drug joints and bring them to justice to serve as deterrant;
- (viii) the Authority of Ibadan South-West Local Government should expedite action on the proposed Police Posts to be sited within the neighbourhood;
- (ix) the Executive Arm of the Government should set machinery in motion to sensitize the general public particularly members of the Landlords and Landladies Association on the provisions of mobilization of Community Committees Law, 1987 (as amended) with a view to guide them on the need to abide by its provisions to improve security state-wide;
- (x) the Nigeria Police, Oyo State Command, should as a matter of duty enforce the ban on the public procession, carnivals and other social functions that are without police permission at Iyana Asuni, Gidarami, Isale-Osi, Born Photo and Foko areas in Ibadan South-West Local Government in particular and generally throughout the State;

- (xi) the community leaders and residents of Iyana Asuni, Gidarami, Isale Osi, Born Photo and Foko areas in Ibadan South-West Local Government Council should cooperate with Security Operatives by making available useful information, to rid the neighbourhood of criminal elements;
- (xii) the Nigeria Police, Oyo State Command should begin a clamp down on all operators of violence around Ita Barika in Foko axis of Ibadan South-West Local Gvoernment with a view to guarantee unmolested traffic flows;
- (xiii) the Commissioner of Police to consider the establishment of more Police Posts (at least four in number) in the area with a view of bringing security closer to the neighbourhood thereby curbing the activities of hoodlums; and
- (xiv) the Commissioner of Police to ensure the arrest and prosecution of the violent and notorious ringleaders terrorizing residents of Isale-Osi, Iyana Asuni and Born Photo Axis of Ibadan South-West Local Government Area
- (xv) the Commissioner of Police should also beef up security in areas like Ayeye, Idikan, Opoyeosa, e.t.c. in Ibadan North-West Local Government Area that are prone to violence.

7.0 URGENT NEED TO RECRUIT ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH OFFICERS TO REPLACE THE RETIRING ONES

Motion made, “that this Honourable House Appeal To The Executive Arm Of Government To Consider Recruitment Of More Environmental Health Officers In The State To Take Care Of The Vacuum Already Created By The Retired Officers” – Hon. M.A. Wahab (Oluyole)

Motion seconded by Hon. A.K. Oloya (Ibadan North-East I), ACCORD Party Whip.

Question, that the Motion be taken put and agreed to.

Debate arising.

The title of the Motion was amended to read thus: “Urgent Need to Recruit Environmental Health Officers to Replace the Retiring Officers”.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved accordingly as follows, “that the Executive Arm of Government be urged to:

- (i) consider recruitment of fresh qualified Environmental Health Officers, many of whom are presently unemployed and abound in large numbers, as soon as possible before the retirement of about three hundred and eighteen (318) Officers, so that, the newly recruited officers will be inducted through practical exposure to Environmental Health Services; and
- (ii) come up with a policy mandating each Local Government Council to recruit and train at least two (02) Environmental Health Officers every other year with the view to strengthen serving Environmental Health Officers with modern techniques”.
