## **5.0 MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE:**

Mr. Speaker read the content of a letter with Ref. No. GOV.2017/05/166 and dated December, 2017 titled "Presentation of 2018 Budget and authored by His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi. In the letter, His Excellency informed the House of his intention to present the 2018 Budget at the day's Sitting i.e. Thursday, 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 at 1.00 p.m.

## **6.0 CORRESPONDENCE:**

Mr. Speaker read the content of a letter from His Royal Highness, Oba Stephen Oyeniyi Olufemi Oparinde II JP the Akibio of Ilora and all sons and daughters of Ilora both home and abroad titled "Letter of Appreciation" dated 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 and signed by the President, Ilora Development Association, Dn. Kayode Ajayi. The letter expressed appreciation to the House for passage into Law of the Oyo State College of Cooperative and Entrepreneurship Studies Bill, 2017. The author appreciated the Speaker and the House for being painstaking in the consideration of the Bill.

## **7.0 PERSONAL EXPLANATION:**

- (i) Hon. Buniyamin Azeez (Ona-Ara) drew the attention of the House to the magnanimous disposition of the Executive Governor of the State, His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi for approving the payment of compensation to those affected by the opening of the Circular road at Badeku town Ona-Ara Local Government Area. He said further that the Governor has promised that payment would be extended to other affected persons. He thereafter, expressed the view that a Vote of Confidence be passed on His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi.

Mr. Speaker asked that a Motion be presented in that respect.

- (ii) Honourable Joshua Oyebamiji (Akinyele I) drew the attention of the House to his vision of providing infrastructural development, improved agricultural activities, improved educational systems and other amenities for his immediate and extended communities. He stated that he was inspired by this vision to contest election into the Oyo State House of Assembly under the ACCORD in 2015. He further stated that the ACCORD under which he realized his ambition has been fractionalized and the leadership had defected to the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP).

He said that for him to continue delivering dividends of democracy to his communities, he needed a platform where this vision could be realized. He was aware of unparalleled achievements of the present administration in the State under the able leadership of the amiable Governor, Senator Abiola Ajimobi. He drew the attention of the House to the numerous achievements of the administration and he therefore, declared his loyalty to All Progressive Congress. (APC).

Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire) Minority Leader.

Debate arising.

Question put and agreed to.

Bill accordingly read a Second Time and referred to the Committee on Investment Monitoring for further scrutiny.

**9.0 NEED FOR THE EXPANSION OF ZONAL OFFICE OF TEACHING SERVICE COMMISSION (TESCOM) FOR BETTER SERVICE DELIVERY AND ADMINISTRATIVE CONVENIENCE**

Motion made, "That this Honourable House Take Cognizance Of The Critical Roles Played By TESCOM In Reviving And Sustaining Teaching And Learning Standard In Public Secondary Schools In The State And Consider The Expansion Of Its Zonal Offices For Quality Service" – Hons. S.O. Ajanaku (Ibadan South-West II), Chairman, Parliamentary Council, J.A. Olaleru (Kajola), Deputy Chief Whip and A.A. Adeleke (Iseyin/Itesiwaju), Co-Sponsors.

Motion seconded by Hon. O.A. Oyatokun (Afijio), Deputy Majority Leader.

Question that Motion be taken put and agreed to.

Debate arising.

By leave of the House, the Motion was referred to the Committee on Education, Science and Technology to meet with TESCOM Management to discuss modalities for implementation and report back to the House.

## **12.0 PRESENTATION OF 2018 BUDGET SPEECH BY HIS EXCELLENCY, THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE, SENATOR ABIOLA AJIMOBI.**

### **2018 Budget Speech:**

His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi presented 2018 Budget Speech. He appreciated God Almighty for giving him another opportunity to present the 2018 Budget Proposals before the Honourable House, the sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) of its kind since becoming the Governor for the State in 2011.

The Governor acknowledged the cooperation of the House of Assembly in moving the State forward. He further solicited for more cooperation in the coming year for the administration to realize the stability agenda as proposed.

He thereafter, highlighted the achievements of 2017 Budget as follows:

#### **(i) Peace, Security and Safety:**

The administration recently relaunched the Oyo State Joint Security Task Force codenamed “Operation Burst” which had tackled the challenges of insecurity in the State. The outfits was being financed through Public Private Partnership (PPP) another initiative of the Administration, i.e. the Security Trust Fund.

#### **(ii) Infrastructure:**

The Administration had improved on its road network and transportation system. Some major access roads in Ibadan, Ibarapa, Iseyin, Saki and Oyo were dualised.

#### **(iii) Environment and Water Supply:**

The Waste Management System had undergone a major restructuring currently an average of 2000 metric tones of waste was being collected per day compared to the average of 500 metric tonnes of previous years.

He stated that water works were being rehabilitated state-wide to improve their delivery capacity. Among those being rehabilitated were Asejire Water Works, Oshegere, Egbeda, Erunmu, Lalupon, Ile Igbon, Iyana Offa and Ejioku.

(iv) **Urban Renewal:**

Towards the realization of urban renewal and attractive environment for investors, Government had established the Bureau of Physical Planning and Development Control to oversee and supervise Urban Development in the State to provide attractive environment for investors. This has given birth to design of Ibadan Master Plan to ensure compliance and controlled development for a safer, healthier and much more easthetically pleasing environment.

(v) **Ibadan Urban Flood Management Project (IUFMP)**

The Ibadan Urban Flood Management Project (IUFMP) Scheme which is being financed by the World Bank, is being extended suitably with visible and strong construction work to achieve the aim of minimizing flood incident in the State, maintaing clean and refuse free cities, improved mass health and security of lives and properties of citizens.

(vi) **Agriculture:**

The Administration has placed premium on the Agriculture Sector and this has serve as Economic repositioning panacea, youth employment generator and wealth creator. The agric investor friendly policies introduced by the administration helped in making farming more attractive for youth and increase indirect available farmland in the State from 21,000 hectres to 271,000 hectres under the aegis of Oyo State Agricultural Initiative (OYSAI). Many companies also established in the State within time under consideration.

(vii) **Education:**

A tremendous improvement had been recorded within the year as a result of educational friendly policy introduced by the administration. This led to good performance recorded in the sector, which included, best result in West African Senior School Certificate (WASSCE) 2016 with an average score of 54.18% when National average was 59%. Another achievement was the construction of three Model Schools across the State.



(viii) **Health:**

Oyo State deployed Free Medical Missions to all the Local Government Areas and one of the few states that have fully domesticated the provision of National Health Insurance Scheme (NHIS) Act 35 so as to increase access to healthcare at a more affordable cost. A N50 Billion endowment fund was established to boost the quality and quantum of world class health infrastructure.

(ix) **Trade, Commerce and Industry:**

His Excellency stated that Oyo State had attained the position of fourth largest economy in Nigeria, the 19<sup>th</sup> largest GDP in Africa and one of the only 5 States to attract Foreign Direct Investment in 2017 according to the National Bureau of Statistics. Since the inception of this administration, 36 companies, with 3884 employees have joined the Manufacturers Association of Nigeria, Oyo State Chapter. The industrialization effort have also birthed the PACE SETTER-POLARIS FREE TRADE ZONE on 2,000 hectares with 175 Companies and an initial \$2m investment and the industrial park had taken off in providing generous discounts on industrial land for private investors. These all pointed to a more stable and virile economy of Oyo State.

(x) **Local Government Administration and Chieftaincy Matters:**

The State Government created 35 new Local Council Development Areas (LCDAs). His Excellency stated that elections would be conducted into the Local Gvoernment Areas and Local Council Development Areas (LCDAs) after the mandatory ninety-day notice effective January, 2018.

His Excellency further stated that the review of the Olubadan Chieftaincy Declaration of 1957 followed due process and aimed at elevating the position of the Olubadan of Ibadan as Imperial Majesty and Consenting Authority.

(xi) **Straff Welfare:**

In boosting staff morale for improved productivity, arrangement had been concluded to release all arrears of promotion from January, 2012 to July, 2017. Govoernment had resolved to Contributory Pension Scheme (CPS) as the best safety mechanism for the retirement benefits.



(xii) **Law and Justice:**

Laws were reviewed to capture the attendant socio economic changes. Also, new Laws were being enacted to ensure that government activities are carried out with due regard to legal and constitutional provision.

The Government is not concentrating on the courts alone. She has also promoted the increased adoption of the Mediation Centre in the Ministry of Justice as the avenue for alternative dispute resolution. Mediation Centres are now being established in all the administrative zones of the State.

(xiii) **Youth Empowerment:**

In the Year 2017, the administration, through the Agency for Youths Development trained 1,500 youth entrepreneurs under the newly introduced Oyo Ajumose Business Leadership Entrepreneurship programme (OYO ABLE). Through this programme, 5,000 youths were targeted for Empowerment in 2018.

A total sum of Fifty Million Naira (₦50 milion) will be utilized to cater for the Three Thousand, One Hundred And Six (3,106) beneficiaries in 12 Local Government Areas In the State.

**2017 Budget Performance:**

Having looked at the performance of the administration at various sectors of the Government, His Excellency gave a summary performance as follows:

#### **Size of 2018 Budget:**

A total budget of Two Hundred and Sixty-Seven Billion, Four Hundred and Thirty-Six Million, Three Hundred and Fifty-Seven Thousand, Nine Hundred and Twelve Naira, Nineteen Kobo (₦267,436,357,912.19) only is being proposed for 2018 fiscal year. The Sectoral Allocation are as follows:
