## **7.0 MATTER OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:**

Pursuant to Order VIII Rule (4) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), raised a Matter of Urgent Public Importance titled “Need To Normalize The Abnormality In The Demand For Tax Clearance And Variation In Collection Of Fees From Parents/Guardians By Public Secondary Schools In The State ”.

Motion made, “that in view of the importance of the Matter which bordered on discrepancies in collection of Tax Clearance from students, Order VIII Rule 4(3) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly should be suspended to allow the House deliberate on the Matter this day” – Hon. S. O. Ajanaku (Ibadan South-West II).

Motion seconded by Hon. M.O. Wahab (Oluyole).

Counter Motion made “that in order to save legislative time, the Matter should be referred to the Committee on Education, Science and Technology for scrutiny and report back to the House” – Hon. A. Musah (Saki-West), Deputy Speaker.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. Oyebamiji (Akinyele I).

## **8.0 FIRST READING OYO STATE FAMILY PLANNING, REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND MATERNITY SERVICE BILL, 2017**

Hon. S.A. Okunlola (Iwajowa) read the Oyo State Family Planning, Reproductive Health And Maternity Service Bill, 2017 co-sponsored by himself, Hons. S. O. Ajanaku (Ibadan South West II), M. A. Wahab (Oluyole), (Mrs.) B. O. Agbaje (Ibadan North I), A. Oseni (Irepo/Olorunsogo), O. S. Akande (Ogbomosho South), L. O. Balogun (Oorelope), and S. O. Oguntade (Egbeda) for the **FIRST TIME**.

## **9.0 COMMITTEE REPORT**

The Report of the Joint Committee on Security and Strategy and Education, Science and Technology co-chaired by Hons. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba) and A.A. Adeleke (Iseyin/Itesiwaju) on Need To Beef Up Security at School of Science, Pade, because of recent armed robbery attack was presented by Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba).

Motion made “that the House do receive the Report as presented for debate” – Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Debate Arising.

**Resolved** accordingly as follows:

- (i) the Commissioner of Police and his men should be commended for rising to the occasion by arresting the gang leader and they should redouble their efforts to arrest other gang members that carried out the attack at Pade School of Science and also promptly ensure their prosecution in court;

- (ii) the Executive Arm of the Oyo State Government through Ministry of Education, Science and Technology should give express approval for the recruitment of more able bodied men as guards to complement the existing security measures on ground at our various Schools;
- (iii) the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology should liaise with the Nigerian Security and Civil Defence Corps, Oyo State Command, to provide security screening and training for security guards in all the Schools in Oyo State to determine their eligibility and to improve their efficiency;
- (iv) The Ministry of Education in collaboration with the School Governing Board and the Parent Teachers Association should consider the requests of the School of Science, Pade as presented by the Principal that:
  - (a) the on-going construction of fence along the school boundary should be completed;
  - (b) the House Master/Mistress quarters, Staff quarters opposite the schools should be fenced;
  - (c) two more gate houses should be constructed and the number of Security Guards be increased from its present three (03) to twelve (12);
  - (d) the Six Hundred and Eighty-Six (~~N~~686,000) Thousand Naira outstanding electricity bills should be settled without further delay;
  - (e) Police Patrol Team should be on standby around the School junction or two armed Police Officers and two personnel of Nigerian Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSDC) be posted to the School to carry out night duties;
- (v) the Chairman of Akinyele Local Government and Akinyele East Local Council Development Area should without further delay remove the thick bushes in and around the School premises to improve visibility;
- (vi) the Chairmen, Akinyele Local Government and Akinyele East Local Council Development Area (LCDA) should step up the completion of the on-going Police station to be staffed by the Police Command;
- (vii) the Police and other Security operatives should step up regular patrol of the School;

- (viii) the Oyo State Police Command and Directorate of State Security Services (DSS) should deploy more Intelligence Officers around our various Schools in the State especially those with boarding facilities to fish out culprits even among students and staff;
- (ix) the G.S.M. service providers should as a matter of security of lives and properties of members of staff and students should improve their services by erecting their mast to cover the School and the surrounding communities;
- (x) Ibadan Electricity Distribution Company (IBEDC) should prioritise electricity supply to all Schools in the State to guarantee regular power supply to prevent hoodlums from using the cover of darkness to perpetrate evils and the School Governing Board and the Parent Teachers Association should give priority to the settlement of electricity Bill to prevent disconnection.

#### **10.0 NEED TO INSTALL ABANDONED TRANSFORMERS IN SOME PARTS OF THE STATE**

Motion made, “that this Honourable House take appropriate legislative action to impress it on the Executive Arm through relevant Government Agencies to install the abandoned transformers procured by State Government in order to improve socio-economic activities of the affected areas in the State” – Hon. O.S. Akande (Ogbomosho South).

Motion seconded by Hon. J. Oyebamiji (Akinyele I).

Question that the Motion be taken put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

By leave of the House, the Matter was referred to the Committee on Local Government and Chieftaincy Matters and State Honours to invite officials of the Ministry of Local Government and Chieftaincy Matters and Rural Electrification Board to a meeting with a view of proffering solutions to the issue and report back to the House.
