8.0 NEED TO STOP REQUEST FOR PAYMENT OF ₦5,000.00 FOR MEDICAL REPORTS FROM CHILDREN VICTIMS OF RAPE/DEFILEMENT IN GOVERNMENT HOSPITALS IN OYO STATE

Motion made, “that this Honourable House appeal to the Executive Arm of Government on the Need Stop Request for Payment of ₦5,000.00 for Medical Report from Children Victims of Rape/Defilement in Government Hospitals in Oyo State” – Hon. (Mrs.) B.O. Oladeji (Ogbomoso North).

Motion seconded by Hon. (Mrs.) B. O. Agbaje (Ibadan North I).

The title was amended by deleting the word “Children”

Question that the motion be taken put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly as follows, “that:

- (i) the Executive Arm of Government through the Hospitals Management Board be urged to exempt victims of rape/defilement from the payment of Five Thousand Naira (₦5,000.00) for obtaining medical report from Government Hospitals;

- (ii) the Executive Arm of Government through the Hospitals Management Board ensure the confidentiality of records of rape/defilement;
- (iii) the Ministry of Health through the mass media and information dissemination Ministry, to sensitise the populace that procurement of medical report by rape/defilement victims is free henceforth;
- (iv) a Joint Committee of Health and Women Affairs engage the Commissioner of Health and other Stakeholders with a view of ensuring compliance with 2(i-iii) above; and
- (v) encourage Members of the public, who are rape/defilement victims (or parents of victims) to report such cases to the appropriate security agencies or government organizations.
