1.0 The House met at 11. 40 a.m. Mr. Speaker took his seat and read the prayer.

6.0 PRESENTATION OF INTERIM REPORT OF JOINT COMMITTEES ON LANDS, HOUSING AND SURVEY AND JUSTICE AND JUDICIARY ON OYO STATE TENANCY BILL, 2016:

The Preliminary Report of the Joint Committees on Lands, Housing and Survey and Justice and Judiciary on Oyo State Tenancy Bill, 2016 Co-Chaired by Hon. P.O. Oyetunji (Surulere/Ogo-Oluwa) and O.S. Akande (Ogbomoso South) as presented by Hon. O.S. Akande.

Motion made, "that the House do adopt the Report of the Joint Committees on Lands, Housing and Survey and Justice and Judiciary as presented for debate"- Hon. K. H Subair (Ibadan South-West I) Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to

Resolved: accordingly in the affirmative.

By leave of the House, the Joint Committees on Lands, Housing and Survey and Justice and Judiciary was to present the Harmonised copy of Oyo State Tenancy Bill, 2016 to the Business and Rules Committee for scheduling/listing for First Reading in the House Business Calendar.

7.0 THIRD READING OF COOPERATIVE SOCIETIES (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2017

- (i) House received the Report of the Committee on Committee on Commerce and Cooperatives that considered Cooperatives Societies (Amendment) Bill, 2017 as presented by Hon. A. Oseni (Irepo/Olorunsogo), Chairman.

Motion made, "that the House do receive the Report of the Committee on Commerce and Cooperatives on Cooperatives Societies (Amendment) Bill, 2017 as presented by the Chairman"- Hon. K. H Subair (Ibadan South-West I) Majority Leader

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly in the affirmative.

- (ii) Motion made "That this Honourable House do constitute itself into the Committee of the Whole House to consider the Report of the Committee on Commerce and Cooperatives that considered Cooperatives Societies (Amendment) Bill, 2017 - Hon. K. H Subair (Ibadan South-West I) Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J.O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly in the affirmative.

IN THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE:

Long Title: Question that Long Title stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 1: Question that Clause 1 stand part of the Bill, put and agreed .

Clause 2: A new Clause 2 was insert thus:

“The Principal Law means the Cooperative Societies, Law 1953 as revised in Year 2000”.

Question that Clause 2 as inserted stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 3: A new Clause 3 was insert thus:

Section 11 is amended by deleting Subsection (3) and replacing with new Subsection 3 as follows:

“If the registrar is Satisfied that any amendment of the by-law is not contrary to this Law or to the regulations, he shall register the amendment. Where the registrar refuses to register an amendment of any by-law, he shall communicate and State reason for his refusal within two weeks to the applicant, who may appeal to the Commissioner within One month from the date of such refusal”

Question that Clause 3 as inserted stand part of the Bill, put and agreed.

Clause 4: Amendment proposed to section 36 (4) thus:

delete the words “two hundred naira” and replace with One Hundred Thousand Naira”.

Question that Clause 4 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed.

Clause 5: Amendment proposed that Section 37 of the Principal

Law be amended by deleting subsection (3) and inserting new subsection (3) as follows:

“Any registered society or any of its officers or members who willfully-

(a) Neglects or refuses to do an act or furnish information; or

(b) Submit false information or return, under subsection (1) and (2) knowing same to be false, shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to imprisonment for six months or to a fine of “one hundred thousand naira” or to both such imprisonment and fine”.

Question that Clause 5 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed.

Clause 6: Amendment proposed that Section 38 of the Principal Law be amended by deleting sub-section (6) and replacing with “Any Officer or member of a registered society who:

- (a) wilfully neglects or refuses to do an act or furnish any information; or
- (b) furnishes false information knowing same to be false; or
- (c) without reasonable cause disobeys an order issued, under subsection (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to imprisonment for six months or to a fine of “one hundred thousand naira” or to both such imprisonment and fine”.

Question that Clause 6 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed.

Clause 7: Amendment proposed that Section 43 sub-section 3 of the Principal Law be amended by deleting
“Two Hundred Naira” and replacing with “One Hundred Thousand Naira”.

Question that Clause 7 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed.

Clause 8: Amendment proposed that Section 44 of the Principal Law be amended by deleting subsection (2) and inserting a new subsection (2) as follows:-

Any person who:

- (a) Willfully
- (b) neglects or refuses to do an act or furnish any information; or
- (c) furnishes information known to be false; or
- (d) without reasonable excuse disobeys an order issued, under subsection (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to imprisonment for six months or to a fine of One Hundred Thousand Naira or to both such imprisonment and fine”

Question that Clause 8 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed.

Clause 9: Amendment proposed that Section 47 subsection 2 of the Principal Law be amended by deleting
“Two Hundred Naira” and replace with “Two Hundred Thousand Naira”.

Question that Clause 9 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed.

Clause 10: Amendment proposed that in Section 48 Sub-Section (2) delete “Two Hundred Naira” and replace with “Two Hundred Thousand Naira”

Question that Clause 10 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed.

Clause 11: Section 50 of the Principal Law was amended by deleting in Sub-Section (6) the word “and the decision of the Commissioner shall be final” after the word “Order” and (ii) Inserting Sub-Section (7) thus:

“(7) The Commissioner shall communicate the decision of the appeal to the appellant within two months from the date of receipt of the appeal”

Question that Clause 11 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed.

Clause 12: Amendment proposed that Section 52 Sub-Section 1 be amended by deleting the word “Governor” and replace with “Commissioner”.

Question that Clause 12 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed.

Clause 13: Amendment proposed that Section 56 sub-section (2) of the Principal Law be amended as follows:

(i) in line 3 delete “twenty naira” and replace with “fifty thousand naira”

(ii) in line 4 delete “two naira” and replace with “five thousand naira”

Question that Clause 13 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed.

Mr. Speaker resumed his seat, Bill reported, read the **THIRD TIME** and passed.

8.0 ADJOURNMENT:
