By the letter His Excellency requested for the consideration and confirmation of appointment of Justice Solomon Adegboyega Akinteye as the President of the Customary Court of Appeal, Oyo State. Mr. Deputy Speaker directed the Clerk of the House to invite the nominee to appear before the House on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2018 at 10.00am for screening. The nominee should also forward forty (40) copies of his resume to the office of the Clerk of the House on or before Wednesday, 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2018

## **7.0 MATTERS OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:**

Motion made, "that Order VIII Rule 4 (3-4) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly be suspended to enable the House take more than one Matter of Urgent Public Importance and deliberate on them this day" - Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South West I) Majority Leader

Motion seconded by - Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader

Question put and agreed to

Resolved accordingly in the affirmative.

(i) Pursuant to Order VIII Rule 4(1) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State

House of Assembly, Hon. J. Oyebamiji raised a Matter of Urgent Public Importance titled "Ghastly Motor Accident at ABA-ODO on Ibadan Oyo Expressway: Need To Take Urgent Safety Measures To Avert Future Occurrence." It has to do with multiple motor accident of Monday 22/01/2018 at Aba-Odo on Ibadan – Oyo express way which claimed several lives and destroyed properties worth millions of naira. The accident was caused by thick haze and thick smoke emanating from a nearby dump site that filled the atmosphere which reduce visibility on the day.

He therefore prayed the House to mandate relevant Government Departments to take urgent safety measures to avert future occurrence  
Motion seconded by Hon. O. A. Oyatokun (Afijio) Deputy Majority Leader  
Debate Arising:

Mr. Deputy Speaker directed that,

- (a) the families of those who lost their lives in the accident be consoled and symphatized with;
  - (b) the FRSC, Oyo State Command be implored to engage in regular sensitization of motorists on the need to obey traffic regualtions when they are behind the wheels;
  - (c) motorists be urged to desist from moving on high speed on the highways especially when visibility is bad, infact they could park in safe place until visibility improves;
  - (d) the Executive Arm of Government through theMinistry of Environment and Oyo State Waste Management Authority be urged to stop people from burning the refuse at Lapite dump site and find other means of managing the refuse which will not be injurious to the neighbourhood;
  - (e) Akinyele Local Government Council and Akinyele East Local Council Development Area should undertake the clearing of the Bushes and trees in the area; and
  - (f) the State Cordinator of the Federal Road Maintenance Agency (FERMA)be implored to engage his department in the repair of damage portions of the road and fill all potholes.
- (ii) Pursuant to Order VIII Rule (1) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. W. A. Wahab (Oluyole) raised A Matter of Urgent Public Importance titled “Need To Give Succour To The Victims Of Fire Incident caused By Falling Of High Tension Wire On Some Residential Buildings At Agric Olomi, Ibadan” He drew the attention of the House to a serious fire incident of Sunday 21/01/2018 which claimed lives and destroyed properties worth millions of Naira at Agric Olomi, Ibadan. He therefore, urged the Honourable House to
- (a) pay condelence visit to the families of the dead victims and those in the Hospital with a view to providing succor for them;
  - (b) to imprest it on Ibadan Electricity Distribution Company (IBEDC) to give compesations to all affected victims in order to alleviate their sufferings, and

- (c) advise members of the Public to desist from any construction under Tension wire  
Motion Seconded by Hon. A. F. Adesina (Ibadan South-East I)

By leave of the House, a Special Committee was constituted to pay condolence visit to the families of the victims and also engage the Ibadan Electricity Distribution Company with a view to determining the culpability of those Houses under high tension line and report back to the House within two weeks.

Two Naira, Thirty Eighty Kobo (N149,065,434,722.38) for Capital Expenditure for the Services of Oyo State of Nigeria in Year Ending on the 31<sup>st</sup> Day of December, 2018, be read the Second Time – Hon. K. H. Subair
