#### **REPORT OF AD-HOC COMMITTEE THAT INVESTIGATED FIRE ACCIDENT CAUSED BY ELECTRICITY SURGE AT AGRIC AREA, OLOMI, IBADAN**

The Report of the Ad-hoc Committee that investigated Fire Accident caused by electricity surge at Agric Area, Olomi, Ibadan was presented by Hon. A.F. Adesina (Ibadan South-East I), on behalf of the Chairman (Hon. K.H. Subair).

**Resolved:** accordingly as follows, that:

- (i) the Executive Arm of Government through the Ministry of Information, Culture and Tourism be urged to sensitize the citizens of the State on the dangers of laying or erecting structures under high tension power lines to avoid future electricity accidents in the State;
- (ii) commend the Management of IBEDC for their quick intervention and succor given to the victims;
- (vii) urge Ibadan Electricity Distribution Company (IBEDC) to be proactive in replacing aged electricity material which are capable of causing havoc at any points in time within the State;
- (viii) urge Ibadan Electricity Distribution Company (IBEDC) to increase their public sensitization on the need for proper wiring of building and other structures;
- (ix) the Ibadan Electricity Distribution Company (IBEDC) should provide safety net wherever their high tension cable overlap with service line to prevent the cable from causing damages on human and properties.
