Mr. Deputy Speaker made the following announcements, that:

## 6.0 MATTERS OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:

Pursuant to Order VIII Rule 4(i) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. Abdul-Ganiyu Oseni (Irepo/Olorunsogo) and Hon. Lukuman Olawale Balogun (Oorelope) raised A Matter of Urgent Public Importance titled “The Urgent Need to Address the Incessant Kidnapping Activities in Irepo, Oorelope and Olorunsogo Local Government Areas of Oyo State”.

Motion made, “that Order VIII Rule 4(3) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly be stepped down to enable the House deliberate on the matter this day”- Hon. O.A. Oyatokun (Afijio), Deputy Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. O.O. Olaleye (Ibadan North II).

Question put and agreed to.

The substantive motion was seconded by Hon. M.O. Olagunju (Oyo East/ West).

Debate Arising.

Question put and agreed to.

**Resolved:** as follows; “that this Honourable House:

- (i) Sympathise with the victims and their families for the harrowing experience and inconvenience suffer;
- (ii) Commend the Commissioner of Police and other security outfits for the umpteen time for rising up to the occasion which led to the arrest of sixteen (16) and urge them not to rest on their oars until criminal activities are reduced to the lowest ebb;
- (iii) Appeal to the Commissioner of Police, Director of SSS and Commandant of the NSCDC to step up surveillance in the affected Local Government areas with a view to ensure safety of lives and properties;
- (iv) Appeal to the Commissioner of Police to ensure that the arrested suspects are prosecuted according to the relevant Laws;
- (v) Mandate the Joint Committee on Security and Strategy and Special Duties to liaise with the Special Adviser to the Governor on Security Matters, Executive Secretary, Security Trust Fund and the Commissioner of Police, Oyo State with a view to seeking progress made on the strategies put in place to address the security challenges;
- (vi) Direct the Transition Committee Chairmen of Oorelope, Irepo and Olorunsogo Local Government areas to provide funds and necessary logistics to the Vigilante groups and other security outfit in their domains for efficient performance of their duties.

## 7.0 PERSONAL EXPLANATION:

Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba), drew the attention of the House to the demise of Hon. M.A. Ajayi who represented Atiba State Constituency in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Oyo State House of Assembly. He described the late Honourable Member as a distinguished and versatile Legislator who served as the Chairman, House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources and Member of Committee on Community Development.

Hon. M.A. Ajayi died at the age of Ninety-Seven (97) years.

A minute silence was observed in his honour.

The Clerk of the House was directed to convey the sympathy and condolence of the House to the family of the deceased.

## 8.0 COMMITTEE REPORTS:

### (i) REPORT OF JOINT COMMITTEE ON SPECIAL DUTIES AND LANDS, HOUSING AND SURVEY THAT VISITED SURULERE AND OGO-OLUWA LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCILS ON COMMUNAL CLASH BETWEEN SURULERE/OGO-OLUWA AND OSUN STATE

The Report of the Joint Committee on Special Duties and Lands, Housing and Survey that visited Surulere and Ogo-Oluwa Local Government Councils on communal clash between Surulere/ Ogo-Oluwa Local Governments and Osun State was presented by Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba), on behalf of the Joint Committees.

Motion made, "that the House do adopt the Report of the Joint Committee that visited Surulere and Ogo-Oluwa Local Government Councils on communal clash between Surulere/ Ogo-Oluwa Local Governments and Osun State as presented for debate" - Hon. K.H Subair (Ibadan SouthWestI), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to

Debate arising.

Question that the recommendation be adopted put and agreed to.

**Resolved:** accordingly as follows, "that:

- (i) all the traditional leaders in Surulere and Ogo-Oluwa Local Governments should be appealed to, to maintain peace and decorum in their domains pending the outcome of the intervention of the Oyo State Government ;
- (ii) the Commissioners of Police, Oyo and Osun States be apprised of the breach of undertaken signed between Ilie, Iresa and Ilosin communities on 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 by Alie of Ilie (Osun State). This is because despite all legal and official caution, Alie of Ilie on Monday, 19<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 arrested and detained Onilosin of Ilosin (Oyo State) for no just cause;

- (i) the Commissioners of Police of Oyo and Osun States, AIG Zone II, Osogbo and other Security Agencies especially Nigerian Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC) be advised to check the excesses of some hoodlums that are taking advantage of land disputes in the border communities of Oyo and Osun States to avert crisis;
- (ii) the Executive Arm of Oyo State Government and Surulere and Ogo-Oluwa Local Government Councils should pay priority attention to the construction of physical projects at border communities sharing boundary with Osun, Kwara and Ogun States for neighbours to feel the physical presence of Oyo State Government;
- (iii) there should be a meeting of the two States' Houses of Assembly on how to broker peace between the States to defuse tension. The two States should maintain status quo until the issue is amicably resolved.
- (iv) The Committees on Special Duties and Land, Housing and Survey should seek audience with Deputy Governor, Chairman, Technical Committee on Boundary Dispute and ensure the issue is amicably resolved.

(ii) **REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC PETITION, HUMAN RIGHTS, ETHICS AND PRIVILEGES ON A PETITION AGAINST FULANI HERDSMEN OPERATING IN ADAFILA VILLAGE, ORIIRE LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCIL**

The Report of Committee on Public Petitions, Human Rights, Ethics and Privileges on its investigation into Fulani Herdsmen operation in Adafila Village, Oriire Local Government where about 22 Acres of Cassava Farm was allegedly destroyed and lives threatened was presented by Hon. M.O. Olagunju (Oyo East/West), Chairman. Motion made, "that the House adopt the Report of the Committee on Public Petition, Human Rights, Ethics and Privileges on a Petition Against Fulani Herdsmen Operating in Adafila Village, Oriire Local Government Council as presented for debate" - Hon. K.H Subair (Ibadan SouthWest), Majority Leader. Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Debate arising.

Question that the recommendation be adopted put and agreed to.

**Resolved:** accordingly as follows, that:

1. The Executive Arm of Government be urged to:
  - (a) hasten its efforts to get all stakeholders involved in finding lasting solution to the perennial problem of destruction of lives and properties by Fulani herdsmen through the Committee On Inter-Community and Inter-Ethnicity Relations;
  - (b) further engage the Myetti Allah Cattle Breeders Association of Nigeria and the Gan Allah Fulani Development Association of Nigeria with the view to curbing the excesses of the Fulani Cattle Rearers;

- (c) charge the Police to be more alive to their responsibility of protecting the lives and properties of the citizenry;
  - (d) direct the Security Trust Fund to provide logistics (for example, the provision of Hilux, Motorcycles and other useful and valuable security gadgets) to beef up security in the affected areas; and
  - (e) ensure that the Peace Committee holds its meetings at least twice a month.
2. Any Fulani herdsman who does not belong to a Fulani settlement (Gaa) be properly investigated and closely monitored;
  3. The Myetti Allah calls Alhaji Tafa to order and ensure that he pays due and appropriate compensation to the Petitioners as remuneration for the destruction of the Petitioner's cassava farmland;
  4. The Baales of the affected areas should be implored to cooperate fully with the Government so as to ensure harmonious co-existence between the various tribes;
  5. This Honourable House:
    - (i) seriously consider making the proposed Anti-Grazing Bill as a subject of Public Hearing so as to enable the General Public air its opinion and be part of the Policy Formulation Process, because it is a matter of public concern.
    - (ii) adopt the above recommendation in respect of any subsequent petitions/correspondences forwarded to the House on Fulani Herdsmen attack; and
  6. the Vigilante Security Outfits in all the Local Government Councils and Local Council Development Areas (LCDAs) should be empowered with necessary logistics and equipment to apprehend the Herdsmen with fire arms.

**9.0 APPEAL TO PROPERTY/BUILDING OWNERS TO CONSTRUCT DRAINAGE CHANNELS AS APPROPRIATE AROUND THEIR BUILDINGS TO SAFEGUARD THE ENVIRONMENT**

Motion made "that this Honourable House deliberate on the way buildings are constructed without necessary drainage channels around such buildings, which result in erosion and damage to the adjoining roads and environment with a view to appealing to all relevant authorities and property owners to construct drainage as appropriate to safeguard the environment" – Hon. P. O. Oyetunji (Ogo-Oluwa/ Surulere).

Motion seconded by Hon. M.O. Olagunju (Oyo East/Oyo West).

Question that the motion be taken put and agreed to.

Debate Arising:

By leave of the House, the Motion was referred to the Committee on Lands, Housing and Survey with a mandate to interface with the relevant MDAs and other Stakeholders and report back to the House within two weeks.
