1.0 APPROVAL OF VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS:

Mr. Speaker announced that he had examined the Votes and Proceedings of Thursday, 23rd November, 2017 and called for comments.

The views of Hons. J.O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader, B.O. (Mrs.) Oladeji (Ogbomoso North), O.S. Akande (Ogbomoso South) and L.O. Balogun (Oorelope) that commended His Excellency for giant developmental stride captured under “Comments under Adjournment” was noted to be captured under Personal Explanation.

Motion made, “That the Votes and Proceedings of Thursday, 23rd November, 2017 as amended be adopted” – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I) Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved accordingly in the affirmative.

2.0 RECOGNITION OF VISITORS:

Mr. Speaker recognized the presence of the following who were in the Gallery to watch the day’s Proceedings:

- (i) some Students and staff of Seed of Life College, Eleyele, Ibadan; and
- (ii) members of the Joint Action Committee of six (06) State owned Tertiary Institutions in the State.

3.0 ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Mr. Speaker made the following announcements: “that

- (i) the Christmas Programme Committee of the Christian Legislators Fellowship International, OYHA would meet in the Division Room after the day’s Sitting;
- (ii) the Committee on Health would be attending a One Day Sensitization Programme on HIV/AIDS Anti Stigma Law to commemorate 2017 World AIDS Day in the House of Chiefs on Thursday, 30th November, 2017 at 10.00 a.m.; and
- (iii) the Committee on Information would meet immediately after the day’s Sitting.

6.0 CORRESPONDENCE:

Mr. Speaker read the content of the following correspondences:

- (i) letter No. NASS/CAN/122/Vol.4/238 authored by the Clerk of the National Assembly titled “Transmission of Constitution (Fourth Alteration) Bill, 2017”; and
- (ii) letter No. EDU 1691/T1/15 dated 27th November, 2017 titled “Re: School Feeding Programme” authored by Professor Adeniyi Olowofela, Commissioner for Education, Science and Technology. Through the letter, the Commissioner tendered unreserved apology to the Honourable Speaker and Members of the House for what happened when he appeared at the Plenary Sitting of the House on Thursday, 23rd November, 2017. The Commissioner withdrew all negative innuendoes the House might have read into his comments. He claimed to hold the House in his esteem and would not undermine the integrity and powers of the House. Honourable Members in their various comments commended the leadership style of Mr. Speaker. They also reacted to comments on the print and electronic media and the social media on the subject matter which they expected to be balanced, objective and non partisan. The Broadcasting Corporation of Oyo State (BCOS) was decried for not relaying the news of the Proceedings of the House of Tuesday, 23rd November, 2017.

Members unanimously agreed that “to err is human, to forgive is divine” and pleaded that the House temper justice with mercy. By leave of the House:

- (i) the Committee on Information was to deliberate on the reasons why the Broadcasting Corporation of Oyo State (BCOS) did not relay the news of the Proceedings of the House on Thursday, 23rd November, 2017 and report back to the House; and
- (ii) the apology of Professor Joseph Adeniyi Olowofela, the Commissioner, Ministry of Education, Science and Technology was accepted and the matter laid to rest.

7.0 MATTER OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:

Pursuant to Order VIII Rule (4) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. A.A. Adeleke (Iseyin/Itesiwaju), raised a Matter of Urgent Public Importance titled “A Call on the Executive Arm of Government to save the State owned Tertiary Institutions from Collapse”. The sponsor explained that the six (06) State owned tertiary institutions had not been able to access their subventions in full due to its reduction to twenty-five percent (25%) since 2016. This reduction had profound negative effects on the educational sector of the State. Presently, these institutions had embarked on total strike action to demand for the payment of fifteen (15) months salary arrears among others.

The House Functionaries and the Committee on Education was to meet with the representatives of the Joint Action Committee of the six (06) State owned Tertiary Institutions after the day’s Sitting.

By leave of Mr. Speaker, the Matter was referred to the Committee on Education, Science and Technology for scrutiny and report back to the House.

8.0 THIRD READING OF A BILL FOR A LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF OYO STATE MEAT AND ABATTOIR REGULATORY AUTHORITY AND FOR CONNECTED PURPOSES, 2017

House received the Report of the Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources that considered A Bill For A Law to provide for the Establishment of the Oyo State Meat and Abattoir Regulatory Authority and for Connected Purposes, 2017 as presented by Hon. S.A. Olalere (Ido), Chairman.

Motion made “that the Report as presented be adopted for debate” – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I) Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba), Party Whip, L.P.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly in the affirmative.

Motion made “that this House do constitute itself into the Committee of the Whole House to consider the Report, including recommendations of the Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources that considered A Bill For A Law to provide for the Establishment of the Oyo State Meat and Abattoir Regulatory Authority and for Connected Purposes, 2017 – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I) Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J.O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved: accordingly in the affirmative.

IN THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

Long Title: Amendment was made to the Long Title thus: that “2015” be deleted and replaced with “2017”

Question, that Long Title as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 1: Amendment proposed thus: This Bill may be cited as Oyo State Abattoir and Meat Regulatory Bill 2017.

Question, that Clause 1 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 2: Amendment proposed thus: Insert the following interpretations appropriately:

- (a) Abattoir to include any slaughter House, slaughter slab, lairage, meat market, meat-shop or premises approved for slaughtering of animals or sale of meat for consumption;
- (b) “Adulterated” means addition of any substance which may be water, blood or any chemical to fish or meat to other purpose or removal or defacing or destruction of any brand, stamp or tag or other distinguishing mark fixed on animal, carcass meat or by-product.
- (c) “Authority” means the Oyo State Abattoir and meat Regulatory Authority established in section 4 of this Bill.
- (d) “Animal” includes cattle, sheep, goat, pig, camel, poultry, fish, snail, rabbit other aquatic animals, wild animals and other animal species that may be declared to be an animal for the purpose of this Bill.
- (e) Board means the Governing Board of the Oyo State Abattoir and Meat Regulatory Authority established in Section 6 of this Bill.

- (f) “By-product” includes blood, hides and skins, bones, horns, hooves, feathers wool and any other by-products derived from slaughtered animals.
- (g) “Carcass” includes the dead body of an animal and any part which has been severed there- from.
- (h) Central Abattoir means an abattoir set up by the State Government with the consent of all the local Government Councils in the State.
- (i) “Controlling Authority” means the local Government for the time being establishing and having control of slaughter houses or abattoirs;
- (j) “Diseased” means infected with any of the diseases or conditions listed in schedule 4 to this law or other disease or condition which the Authority may be notice declared to be a disease;
- (k) Environmental Health Officer” means an Environmental Health Officer of the State Ministry of Environment and Water Resources and the Local Government working in collaboration to enforce the provisions of this Bill;
- (l) “Government” means the Government of Oyo State;
- (m) Laboratory means a building with scientific laboratory equipment for observation, experimentation, testing and analysis the Health status of animal;
- (n) “lairage” means any premises used for the confinement of animals awaiting slaughter;
- (o) Laboratory: A building with scientific laboratory equipment for observation, experimentation, testing and analysis the Health status of animals;
- (p) Local Government means all the Local Government Areas including the Local Council development Area;
- (q) “Nuisance” include keeping of any animal or bird in the lairage, animal market, any abattoir premises in a manner as to be capable of causing injuries to the health of man or molesting neighbors or of other animals of birds or suffering from noxious or contagious disease;
- (r) “Ministry” means the Ministry of Agriculture, Natural Resources and Rural Development;

- (s) “Other Meat Inspector” means an animal health Superintendent/Technologist who inspects meat or hides and skin under the supervision of a Veterinary Officer;
- (t) “Paper Sanitary Condition” means the keeping an abattoir, meat processing plant, fish and meat cold stores, fish and meat markets and other meat preservation premises properly cleansed, drained, sufficiently lightened, ventilated and provided with adequate supply of water;
- (u) “Permanent Secretary” means the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry”;
- (v) “Protective Clothing” means appropriate professional dressing specified by the authority for use while on duty by veterinary officers, other meat inspectors, butchers and other abattoir workers to prevent contamination;
- (w) “State” means Oyo State of Nigeria
- (x) “Withdrawal Period” means the specified period when drug usage should stop before the animal can be slaughtered for human consumption;

Question, that Clause 2 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 3 Insert a new Clause 3 thus: “A controlling Authority may delegate to the State or Authority its functions Controlling Authority with respect to the establishment, maintenance and regulation of abattoirs in the State”;

Question, that Clause 3 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 4: Amendment proposed to re-number Clause 3 as Clause 4 and amend Sub-Clause (c) as follows add after ‘property’ ‘movable or immovable”

Question, that Clause 4 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 5: Question, that Clause 4 becomes Clause 5 and stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 6: Clause 5 was re-numbered as Clause 6 and amendment proposed as follows:

- (i) (a) re-couch, Sub-Clause (b) –(f) as follows:

- (b) “inspect and examine all animals intended for slaughter for the purpose of ascertaining whether such animal is infected with a disease or pregnant or did not meet withdrawal period requirements and therefore should not be slaughtered or whether the carcass or meat or by-product is infected or adulterated or contain residue of veterinary drugs in excess of maximum permissible levels and therefore not fit for human consumption”.
- (c) “Set and enforce regulatory standards for the processing, quality, hygiene and packaging of meat for sale for human consumption.
- (d) ‘Specify and enforce standards for transporting and storage of meat, fish, and by products.
- (e) Prescribe method for assessment and payment of compensation for condemned animals;
- (f) Prescribe procedure for the slaughtering of animals including stunning.
- (ii) Sub-Clause (g) stand part of the Bill.
- (iii) Re-couch Sub-clauses (h) – (l) as follows:
 - (h) inspect and examine any meat and by-products derived from slaughter animals and ensure that hides and skins and other by-products are processed in appropriate manner.
 - (i) issue veterinary certificate of fitness to animals considered fit for slaughter and certificate of conformity for carcass, meat and animal by-products after veterinary inspection.
 - (j) define minimum standards of sanitary facilities for abattoirs, processing plants, meat markets and cold stores for meat and fish.
 - (k) assess, advise and enforce hazard analysis and Critical control Point (HACCP) at all levels of animals production, meat processing, preservation packaging and sale.
 - (l) issue Certificate of Registration for abattoir” processing plants, meat markets, cold stores for meat and fish.
- (iv) Sub-Clause (m) stand part of the Bill.
- (v) insert new Sub-Clauses (n), (o), and (p) as follows;
 - (n) set minimum standards for the location, design construction, drainage, waste and effluent disposal

for abattoirs, meat processing plants, fish and meat cold stores and fish and meat markets and other meat preservation premises;

- (o) facilitate the registration and continuous training of butchers, meat sellers, other workers in the abattoir, cold stores, fish and meat markets and laboratories.
- (p) Prescribe and enforce routine health checks for veterinary officers, other meat inspectors, butchers, abattoir workers, fish and meat cold stores, fish and meat market and laboratories to prevent spread of infectious diseases and contamination of meat and by-product.

Question, that Clause 6 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 7: Clause 6 was re-numbered as Clause 7 and Sub-Clause (2) was re-written as follows:

- (a) “The Commissioner who shall be the Chairman;
- (b) The General Manager of the Authority
- (c) Director of Veterinary Services of Oyo State
- (d) Director, Public Health Oyo State Ministry of Health
- (e) A representative of Ministry of Local Government and Chieftaincy matters.
- (f) A representative of the Ministry of Environment Water Resources.
- (g) Ministry of Justice
- (h) A representative of the Association of Local Government of Nigeria, (ALGON) Oyo State Chapter.
- (i) 3 members from the Private Sector – with cognate experience”.

Question, that Clause 7 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 8: Question, that Clause 8 be re-numbered and stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 9: Question, that 9 be re-numbered and stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 10: Question, that Clause 10 be re-numbered and stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 11: Question, that Clause 11 be re-numbered and stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 12: Clause 11 was re-numbered as Clause 12 and amendment proposed thus:

Sub-Clause(c) and (e) were expunged.

Sub-Clause (f) becomes Sub-clause (c)

Question, that Clause 12 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 13: Clause 12 be re-numbered as Clause 13 and amendment proposed thus:

(i) Re-write the side notes as follows, "Appointment and Qualification of a General Manager'.

(ii) In Sub-Clause 1, after the word 'Governor' add "from the Civil Service"

(iii) Amendment proposed thus: "re-couch Sub-Clause (2a) as follows: the General Manager shall be a Registered Veterinary Surgeon with at least fifteen years post qualification experience in meat hygiene and with additional qualification in meat hygiene and inspection or veterinary Public Health'.

(iv) Expunge Sub-Clause 3 and replace with, "responsible for the discipline of staff and such other duties as the Board may assign to him"

Question, that clause 13 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 14: Clause 13 was re-numbered as Clause 14 and amendment proposed thus:

(i) Insert Sub-Clause (2) thus:" staff of the Authority shall enjoy conditions of service as applicable in the Civil Service of Oyo State"

Question, that Clause 14 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 15: Question, that Clause 15 be re-numbered and stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 16: Clause 15 was re-numbered as Clause 16 and amendment proposed thus: the Clause was re-written as follows:

(1) "Every abattoir, meat processing plants, fish and meat cold stores, fish and meat markets, fish and meat shops and other meat preservation premises shall be approved, registered and issued a certificate of registration by the Authority which shall be renewed annually.

- (2) An application for grant of a license for the registration of any abattoir, meat processing plant, fish and meat cold stores, other meat preservation premises, meat market and meat shop shall be as prescribed in schedule 2 to this law.
- (3) A valid certificate of registration issued to an operator of any abattoir, meat processing plant, fish or meat cold stores, other meat preservation premises and meat shops, may be cancelled at any time by the Authority if the building and the facilities has fallen to disrepair or are considered to be unhygienic and unsafe for handling of animals, meat and fish meant for human consumption.
- (4) An application for a license for the operation of any abattoir meat processing plant, fish or meat cold stores, other meat preservation premises shall be accompanied by the payment of appropriate fees as specified in Schedule 3, which may be reviewed by the authority from time to time.

Question, that Clause 16 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

- Clause 17: (i) Clause 16 was re-numbered as Clause17 and amendment proposed thus:
- (ii) In Sub-Clause (2) expunged “hygienic” then add “proper sanitary”
 - (iii) Re-couch Sub-Clause (3) as follows:
“Every abattoir shall have adequate space and facilities as specified by the authority for ante-mortem inspection of animals and post-mortem inspection of meat and by-products.
 - (iv) That Sub-Clause (4) stand part of the Bill.
 - (v) Amendment proposed as follows:
“Every Abattoir shall have adequate supply of potable water, provision of adequate and proper waste management, provision of cloak room, adequate and standard conveniences and provision of health post/first aid room”.
 - (vi) In Sub-Clause (6) after “times “add “to the satisfaction” of a Veterinary Officers”
 - (vii) That Sub-Clause (7) stand part of the Bill.
 - (viii) insert new Sub-Clause(8) as follows:

“If a veterinary Officer is of the opinion that any premises that are, by reason of their veterinary conditions or for any other reason, unsuitable for the slaughter, storage, sale or carriage of animals, meat, fish, hides or skins, he may, by writing addressed to the occupier of the premises or to the person for the time being in charge or appearing to be in charge thereof, order the removal there from of any animal, meat, fish, hides or skins, and may prohibit the use of such premises for any of the aforesaid purposes until the defective condition had been remedied to his satisfaction”.

Question, that Clause 17 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 18: (i) Clause 17 was re-numbered as Clause 18 and amendment proposed thus:

Sub-Clause (4d) to read “Regulate temperature of the fish or meat during transit to a maximum of 4 degree centigrade”.

Question, that Clause 18 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 19: Clause 18 was re-numbered as Clause 19 and amendment proposed thus:

(i) In Sub-Clause 1(a) after the word “law, add “including fund generated by the Authority in the exercise of its functions and powers under the law”.

(ii) add Sub-Clause (I)(b) thus: “Any fund generated by the Authority pursuant to section 18(i) (a) above shall be shared with local Government councils where registered abbatoirs and slaughter houses are located and sharing formula shall be 50% for the Authority and 50% for the Local Government Councils which shall in turn share on prorata basis”.

(iii) Insert new Sub-Clause 4 thus: “The Authority shall establish and maintain a fund from which shall be defrayed all its expenditures”.

(iv) insert new Sub-Clause 5 thus: “There shall be paid or credited to the fund”.

(a) Such sum as may be appropriated from time to time.

- (b) All monies paid to the Authority by way of grants, subsidies, donations, gifts, charges, fees, subscriptions, interests and royalties;
- (c) All monies which may vest in the Authority under any enactment; and
- (d) All other sums or property which may in any manner become payable to or vested in the Authority in respect of any matter incidental to its powers or functions under this law.

Question, that Clause 19 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 20: Clause 19 was re-numbered as Clause20 and amendment proposed thus:

- (1) In Sub-Clause(1) add before 'subject' thus: "The Authority shall have power to as may be allowed under the extant financial regulation of the Government".
- (2) insert a new Sub-Clause 5 thus "Invest any monies belonging to it by way of endowment (whether for general or special purposes)".

Question, that Clause 20 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 21: Question, that Clause 21 stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 22: Question, that Clause 22 stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 23: Question, that Clause 23 stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 24: Amendment proposed thus: In Sub-Clause (1)

- (i) add "or keep" before slaughter in line 2,
- (ii) add after animal "or meat' in line 2
- (iii) add after Abattoir "or processing plant or cold store with invalid operating license'.
- (iv) In Sub- Clause(2)
add after Authority in line 3 'or with invalid operating license".
- (v) In Sub-Clause (3)
Add " In the performance of his duty under this law"
before "shall"
- (vi) original Sub-Clause (4) becomes Sub-Clause(5)

Question, that Clause 24 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 25: Question, that Clause 25 stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.
