1.0 APPROVAL OF VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS:

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved accordingly in the affirmative.

5.0 ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Mr. Speaker made the following announcements: "that

- (i) Muslim Honourable Members would meet in the Division Room after the day's Sitting for an important meeting;
- (ii) the Committee on Health would be attending HIV/AIDS Anti Stigma sensitization meeting with Officials of the State Agency on The Control of HIV/AIDS this day;

(iii) the House Functionaries and Members of the Committee on Education, Science and Technology would hold a meeting with Officials of the Ministry of Finance and Budget and the Office of the Accountant-General of the State to deliberate on crisis rocking tertiary institutions in the State and profer the way forward after the day's Sitting; and

(iv) the Committee on Public Petitions and Human Rights would meet in the Conference Room, New Office Complex after the day's Sitting with Officials of the Ministry of Agriculture and Natural Resources and other invitees to scrutinize the petition on Fulani herdsmen operations in Adefila Village, Oriire Local Government Area.

- (iii) High Court (Further Amendment) No. 2 Bill, 2017.

7.0 COMMITTEE REPORTS:

(A) House received the Report of the Joint Committee on Works and Transport, Local Government, Chieftaincy Matters and State Honours - Hons Hon. B.S. Badmos (Akinyele II) and M.A. Sangodipe (Saki East/Atisbo), Co- Chairmen on Need to Expedite Action on the Rehabilitation Of Moniya –Iseyin Road to prevent accident on the Road as presented by Hon. B.S. Badmos (Akinyele II).

Motion made “that the House do adopt the Report of the Joint Committee on Local Government, Chieftaincy Matters and State Honours and Works and Transport as presented for debate” – Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Debate arising.

Resolved accordingly as follows: that

- (i) the Executive Arm of Government through the Vehicle Inspection Department of the Ministry of Works and Transport should carry out periodic inspection of vehicles plying all roads in the State;

- (ii) the Executive Arm of Government through the Highways Department of the Ministry of Works and Transport should accommodate the re-construction of the culvert over Odo-Eran River, Moniya in Year 2018 Budget Proposal of the Ministry;
- (iii) measures be put in place by the Authority of Akinyele Local Government Area towards the rehabilitation of Moniya – Iseyin Road by providing speed breakers, erecting “No Parking”, “No Waiting” and “No Trading” sign posts around Odo Eran market and creating a space around Odo-Eran, Moniya market for commercial tricycle operators in the area;
- (iv) the Executive Arm of Government through the Ministry of Environment and Water Resources should as a matter of urgency, undertake the dredging of the Odo-Eran river at Moniya to prevent flooding; and
- (v) the Nigeria Police Force, Oyo State Command through the Divisional Police Officer, Moniya should as a matter of duty deploy more Policemen to Odo-Eran, Moniya junction to direct and ease flow of traffic in the area.

(B) House received the Report of the Committee on Special Duties and Development that interacted with Officials of the National Population Commission over the on-going Enumeration Area Demarcation (EAD) exercise in the State as presented by the Chairman – Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba).

Motion made “that the House do adopt the Report as presented for debate” – Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Debate arising.

Resolved accordingly as follows “that:

- (i) His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi be commended for his unprecedented support and understanding given to the National Population Commission over the on-going Enumeration Area Demarcation (EAD) exercise in the State;
- (ii) the Executive Governor be urged to sustain support to the National Population Commission in terms of providing necessary logistics to supplement already provided logistics for the Commission by the Federal Government. This would really assist the Commission in achieving more successes in subsequent phases expected to be carried out in the State;

- (iii) His Royal Majesty, Oba Lamidi Adeyemi, the Alaafin of Oyo and other traditional rulers in Ibadan North-West and Olorunsogo LGAs where the exercise had so far been conducted be commended for their unflinching support to the National Population Commission during the flag-off campaign exercise in their domains. This would encourage other traditional rulers in the State to embrace the laudable programme when it is their turn;
- (iv) the National Population Commission intensify its efforts on the sensitization of the public on the importance of Enumeration Area Demarcation exercise towards achieving a verifiable and acceptable census result. This could be done by sponsoring jingles in local dialects in most preferred media outlets by people in each geo-political zone in the State. This would greatly assist the implementation of subsequent exercises;
- (v) the Ministry of Local Government and Chieftaincy Matters be urged to direct the Transition Committee Chairmen of Local Government Areas (LGAs) and Local Council Development Areas (LCDAs) to provide suitable accommodation for Field Officers of the National Population Commission posted to their respective LGAs and LCDAs for smooth implementation of Enumeration Area Demarcation exercises being carried out by the National Population Commission;
- (vi) the National Population Commission be urged to submit periodic report on the Enumeration Area Demarcation exercise in the State to the Oyo State House of Assembly for constituents' engagement. This is because Honourable Members of the Oyo State House of Assembly represent Oyo State populace and can easily educate the people more on the activities of the Commission;
- (vii) the Honourable Members of the House should get prepared to give necessary assistance and support to National Population Commission whenever the EAD exercise is being carried out in their respective constituencies; and
- (viii) that Honourable Members of Oyo State House of Assembly be commended for sensitizing the populace on the Enumeration Area Demarcation (EAD) exercise.

8.0 CURBING INDISCRIMINATE SITING OF COOKING GAS RETAIL OUTLETS IN OYO STATE THROUGH PROPER PLANNING

Motion made, “that this Honourable House discourage the indiscriminate siting of cooking gas retail outlets along roadsides and within residential areas to minimize fire outbreak sometimes leading to loss of lives and properties by calling on the relevant Government MDAs to step up their monitoring and supervision efforts” - Hon. (Mrs.) B.O. Oladeji (Ogbomoso North).

Motion seconded by Hon. L.O. Balogun (Oorelope).

Question, that the Motion be taken put and agreed to.

Debate arising.

By leave of the House, the Joint Committee on Environment and Works and Transport was to interface with the Officials of the Ministries of Environment and Works and Transport, Bureau of Physical Planning, Development and Control and other Stakeholders on issues raised in the Motion and report back to the House within two weeks.
