## 4.0 **MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE:**

Mr. Speaker read content of a Letter with Ref. No. GOV2018/05/195, dated 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2018 authored by His Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi and titled "Re:\$1 Billion Deduction from the Excess Crude Oil Account (ECA) to procure Military Equipment in support the Armed Forces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria in fighting Insurgency". The Letter sought for the approval of the House to authorize the Federal Government to deduct the State's Share of the Sum of \$1 Billion from the Excess Crude Account (ECA) for the procurement of Military equipment to support the Armed Forces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria in its operations in fighting insurgency and other security challenges in the Country.

Debate Arising.

**6.0 CORRESPONDENCE:**

The Clerk read a Correspondence titled “Notification of the passage unto glory of Agbaakin Olanipekun Adesokan”. The letter dated 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2018 informed the House of the demise of the Patriarch, role model, father, distinguished commercial Attorney and Great Politician at the ripe age of 82 years. He died on Tuesday, 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2018.

He started his political career as Councilor in the old Oyo Local Government Council in 1976, a Deputy Speaker in the Oyo State House of Assembly (1979 – 1983). He later joined forces to form NADECO and resuscitate Afenifere upon cancellation of June 12 election.

Later, Agbaakin Joseph Olanipekun Adesokan served as the Commissioner of Local Government and Chieftaincy Matters and Agriculture, Natural Resources and Rural Development in the administration of the former Executive Governor of Oyo State, late Alhaji Lam Adesina (1999 – 2003).

The House observed a minute silence in honour of the late Agbaakin Joseph Olanipekun Adesokan.
