6.0. **SECOND READING OF PRIVATE VETERINARY PREMISES AND VETERINARY ESTABLISHMENT (REGULATORY) BILL, 2017**

Motion made and question proposed "That a Bill for a Law to Provide for the Registration and Regulation of Private Veterinary Premises and Veterinary Establishment and For Connected Purpose be read a **SECOND TIME**" - Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), Majority Leader.

Bill accordingly read a **SECOND TIME** and referred to the Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources for further scrutiny and report to the House.

7.0 **PRESENTATION OF REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY ON LAUTECH MATTERS**

The Report of Committee on Education, Science and Technology on its interaction with the Commissioner and Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education, the Vice Chancellor, Registrar, Trade Unions of LAUTECH and other Stakeholders on clarification on the actual indebtedness of the owner States and proactive measures to be taken to avert another indefinite industrial actions by the Trade unions in the Institution was presented by Chairman of the Committee, Hon. A.A. Adeleke (Iseyin/Itesiwaju),

Motion made, "That the House do receive the Report of the Committee on Education, Science and Technology as presented by the Chairman for debate" - Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South West I)

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

Question that the recommendations be adopted put and agreed to.

**Resolved** accordingly as follows, "that:

I "that the two Executive Governors of Oyo and Osun States be urged to compassionately:

- (a) sustain palliative measures of the monthly release of Two Hundred and Ninety Two Million Naira (₦292,000,000.00) each to Ladoke Akintola University of Technology (LAUTECH), Ogbomoso, to pay salary arrears to workers in the institution

- to prevent another industrial action being proposed by the Staff Unions;
- (b) expedite action towards the release of the report of the Technical Committee Set up to look into the report of the Visitation Panel to LAUTECH;
  - (c) mandate the Audit Firm i.e. KPMG assigned to audit the account of LAUTECH to expedite action and submit its report within three weeks assigned; and
- II all the Workers Union in the institution i.e. Academic Staff Union of Universities (ASUU), Senior Staff Association of University (SSANU), National Association of Academic Technologists (NAAT) and the Non-Academic Staff Union (NASU) be appealed to suspend all plans towards embarking on another strike action”.

## 8.0 NEED FOR URGENT FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR SHOOTING STARS SPORT CLUB

Motion made, “That this Honourable House seriously deliberate on the challenge of Relegation Starring the Shooting Stars Sport Club (3SC) in the Face with a View to Appealing to the Executive Arm of Government to Provide Financial Support For the Football Team to Safe It From Relegation” – Hon. A.F. Adesina (Ibadan South- East I).  
Motion seconded by Hon. O. A. Oyatojun (Afijio), Deputy Majority Leader.

Question that the Motion be adopted put and agreed to.

**Resolved:** accordingly as follows:

1. That the Executive Arm of Government be urged
  - (a) “to urgently assist the 3SC Football Club by releasing take-off grant for the team to meet financial issues such as clearance of players travelling to honour away matches to be used for 2<sup>nd</sup> stanza beginning in May 21, 2017;
  - (b) ensure the release of quarterly funds on first line charge basis as against releasing monthly funds when salaries are being paid. (This is in arrears of four/five months now); and
- 2 The House leadership to meet the Executive on the issue of 3SC to ensure the implementation of the Resolution. This is in view of the fact that 3SC is a brand for the State Government and the team must not be allowed to sink in the relegation water; and

3. the Executive Arm of Government be urged also extend the similar gesture of assistance to other football teams competing in the Local and National Football League.
4. the Management of 3SC be urged to come up with a blueprint on how to generate Revenue to sustain the Football Team.
