5.0 **THIRD READING OF HOSPITALS (PRIVATE) REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT), BILL 2016**

IN THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

Long Title: Amendment proposed that:
the year "2000" to read "1946".

Question that the Long Title as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 1: Amendment proposed that the word "Hospitals" be deleted and replace with "Health Facilities".

Question that Clause 1 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 2: Amendment proposed thus:

(i) in line 2 replace "2000" with "1946"

(ii) after "Permanent Secretary" a new interpretation be inserted thus: "Secondary Health Care and Training Department" means the Department in the Ministry of Health that is charged with the responsibility of overseeing the activities of Private Health Care facilities; and

(iii) Section 2 of the Principal Law is further amended thus:

- (a) the interpretation of "medical practitioner" be deleted and substitute them with the words "Health Care practitioners" means and includes a health practitioner in the medical, dental, nursing, medical laboratory, community health, optical services and any persons whose services are related to health care delivery; and
- (b) under interpretation "Private hospital" the words "Diagnostic Centres" be inserted after the word "dressing room in line '3'.

Question that Clause 2 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 3:

Amendment proposed that:

- (i) the proposed amendment to Clause 3 Stand Part of the Bill.
- (ii) Amendment further proposed to the Principal Law thus:
 - (a) the word "hospital" be deleted and substitute it with the words "health facilities"; and
 - (b) the words "medical practitioner" be deleted and replace them with the words "Health Care Practitioner" wherever they appear.

Question that Clause 3 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 4: Amendment proposed that:

- (i) in Sub-Clause (4a) line 5 after the word "form" insert the words "and sum"
- (ii) that Sub-Clause 4 (b) be deleted, and
- (iii) that a new Sub-Clause be inserted as Sub-Section 6 (4) of the Principal Law and to read thus: "mandatory submission of data on annual health activities by private health care providers shall be a prerequisite for the yearly renewal of certificate of registration.

Question that Clause 4 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 5: Question that Clause 5 Stand Part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 6: Question that Clause 6 Stand Part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 7: Amendment proposed thus:

- (i) in line 4 the word "Fifty Thousand Naira" be deleted and replaced with One Hundred Thousand Naira"; and

(ii) in line 6 the word "Ten thousand naira be deleted and replaced with Twenty-Five Thousand Naira".

Question that Clause 7 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 8: Question that Clause 8 Stand Part of the Bill put and agreed to.

- (ii) considering the importance and contributions of Higher School Certificate (HSC)/Advance Level Programme in the past to our Education Advancement and because education is in the Concurrent List of the 1999 Constitution (Amnded) of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, the Executive Arm of Government or the House should come up with policies legislations that will pave way for Higher School Certificate (HSC) resuscitation.
