8.0 APPEARANCE BEFORE THE HOUSE:

Pursuant to the directive of the House on Tuesday, 25th October, 2016, the underlisted Government officials appeared before the House

to brief the House on measures taken to reduce the menace of Street begging and its attendant consequences:

The Commissioners made their presentation and fielded questions from Hon. Members afterwards. The Commissioner, Ministry of Environment and Water Resources in his presentation informed the House of efforts taken to reduce the menace of street begging. This included collaboration with the Ministry of Women Affairs, Social Welfare Community Development and Poverty Alleviation in clearing the Streets of destitutes and beggars.

The Ministry had also engaged the Hausa Community in a stakeholder meeting due to the fact that the Hausa constituted Sixty percent (60%) of the destitute population. He also informed the House that the Ministry was working on a draft bill which when passed into law would further assist the Ministry to Curb the social menace of street begging. He further added that the Ministry had approached Traditional Psychiatric Healers Association to assist the process of evacuation of destitutes on the streets.

The Commissioner, for Women Affairs in her presentation informed the House of the Ministry's efforts which included collaboration with the Ministry of Justice, in drafting a bill on Oyo State Street Begging and Trading Prohibition Law, 2017. Also, the Ministry had embarked on joint raiding of destitutes, Street beggars and street traders in collaboration with the Ministry of Environment and Water Resources. In addendum, the Ministry also embarked on sensitization and advocacy programmes to sensitize the public against street begging.

Honourable Members in their various comments commended the Ministries efforts taken so far in curbing the social menace. Members observed that the Ministry of Women Affairs should do sometime about

women beggars who back infants along streets in Ibadan at night. Members also advised that the two Ministries, other stakeholders synergize and intensify their efforts towards ensuring that the menace of destitution and street begging is reduced to the barest minimum in Oyo State.

By Mr. Speaker's order the Committee on Environment and Ecology was mandated to continue to interface with the Ministries in respect of the subject matter.

The officials took a bow and were discharged from the chambers.

9.0 THIRD READING OF OYO STATE SECURITY TRUST FUND (FURTHER AMENDMENT) BILL, 2016:

Subair (Ibadan South West I), Majority Leader. Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire) Minority Leader.

Clause 8: Amendment Proposed thus:

- (i) re- number Clause 7 as Clause 8;
(ii) In line 3 of Sub-Clause 1 delete N5,000.00 and replace with N20,000.00

Question, that clause 8 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 9: **Question,** that clause 8 be re-numbered as Clause 9 and stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Mr. Speaker, resumed his seat, Bill reported, read the **THIRD TIME** and passed.

10.0 SECOND READING OF OYO STATE COLLEGE OF COOPERATIVES AND ENTREPRENEUSHIP STUDIES BILL, 2017

Motion made and question proposed “that A Bill For A Law To Provide For the Establishment, Incorporation, Constitution and Function of Oyo State College of Cooperative and Entrepreneurship Studies be read the **SECOND TIME**” - Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South West I), Majority Leader.

Motion made “that this Honourable House deliberate on the Statutory Functions of the Local Government with a view to advising the State Joint Local Government Allocation Committee to be fair and equitable in the sharing of fund from the Federation Account to the Local Governments so as to bring development to the people at the grassroots and complement the effort of the State Government” – Hon. G. J. Oyekola (Atiba) LP
