a. Supply and installation of Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI), the Fluoroscopy and other remaining medical items by **Biostadt**. The total sum is put at **₦2.098** Billion inclusive of variation sought which is negotiable;

b. Construction of all shaft for the installation of elevators and provision of 3 Phase power supply to energize the College of Medicine and House Officers quarters - **Ahmak**; and

c. Remedial works at Oyo Outreach Centre- **Ahmak**, i.e. **₦403,999,318.37**

(ii) The Executive Arm of Government should ensure the recovery of the total sum of **₦562,478,469.18** from the under listed contractors for non-performance;
