**Resolved:** accordingly, as follows "that

- (i) The Executive Arm of State Government should take priority of the Agency's funding seriously by releasing quarterly fund to enable it provide prompt release of relief materials to disaster victims.
- (ii) Oyo SEMA should fast track all processes leading to procurement of relief materials from National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA)
- (iii) The Office of the Head of Service (HOS) should be informed about need to establish the following Departments:
  - (a) Relief and Rehabilitation;
  - (b) Planning Research and Trainings, and
  - (c) Search and Rescue
- (iv) as the new Local Government Transition Committees are in place, there is need for the implementation of the establishment of Emergency Management Committee at Local Government Level as Section 19 (i) SEMA Law, 2008 provided, and
- (v) The Executive Arm of the State Government should as a matter of necessity establish "Emergency Trust Fund" to take care of any disaster just like Security and Education Trust Funds Laws.
