6.0 MATTER OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:

Pursuant to Order 8 Rule(4) (I) of the Standing rules of Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. W. O. Akinmoyede raised A Matter Of Urgent Public Importance titled:-“Need For Urgent Intervention Of Executive Arm Of Oyo State Government to rehabilitate the damaged portion of Oloke Omi and Ejioku junction along Ibadan – Iwo-Osogbo road”

The motion was referred to Committee on Works and Transport and the Office of Rt. Honourable Speaker to meet with the Oyo State Road Maintenance Agency (OYSROMA) for immediate remedy.

7.0 SCREENING OF NOMINEES INTO THE BOARDS OF CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION (CSC) AND OYO STATE UNIVERSAL BASIC EDUCATION BOARD (SUBEB)

(A) OYO STATE UNIVERSAL BASIC EDUCATION BOARD (SUBEB)

The underlisted nominees appeared before the House for screening as Chairman and Full-Time Board Members of State Universal Basic Education Board (SUBEB)

- (i) Mrs. Aderonke Olufunmilayo Makanjuola -Full-Time Chairman
- (ii) Mrs. Yemisi Olufunmilayo Fakoyede -Full-Time Member
- (iii) Hon. Adeniran Philemon -Full-Time Member

They were put on Oath and thereafter presented their resumes.

- (i) **Mrs. Aderonke Olufunmilayo Makanjuola** was born on 1st August, 1960 she graduated from University of Ibadan 1991. She started her career in 1981 as a Teacher in Queen’s School Apata, Ibadan before she was appointed as Local Inspector of Education and served at Egbeda Local Government. She rose to the position of Assistant Director of Education in the Oyo State Ministry of Education, she was appointed Deputy Director in 2002 and Executive Secretary, Board for Technical and Vocational Education (BOTAVED). She served as Permanent Secretary from 1st February 2015 to 4th July, 2017 when she retired. She was a seasoned technocrat, she was found appointable as the Full-Time Chairman.

(ii) **Mrs. Oluyemisi Olufunmilayo Fakoyede** was born on 17th September, 1958. She possessed HND in Secretarial Studies and Master of Communication Arts from University of Ibadan from in 1991. She joined the Service of the Nigeria National Petroleum Corporation, Jos as Trainee Officer, Way bills in 1981 to 1982. She was a Network Officer (Network Department) in the Société Generate Bank between 1982 – 1984 where she retired as Cash Officer in December 1987. She served as Full Time Member, State Universal Basic Education Board between 2011 – 2015. She was a public servant of repute. She was found appointable as a Full-Time Member.

(iii) **Hon. Philemon Adegoke Adeniran** was born on 6th January 1944, in Igbeti, Olorunsogo Local Government Oyo State. He attended University of Ife between 1972 and 1976 where he obtained B.Sc. Hons (Social-Science). He was a public Office with Oyo State Government between 1968 and 1983. He served as General Manager Trans City Transport Company Ltd. of Oyo State, Ibadan between 1996-2003. He was a Member of House of Representatives between 2003 and 2007. He was a dutiful civil servant and a revered politician. He was found appointable as a Full-Time Member. Hon Members expressed delight in the sagacity of the Executive Arm for the quality of the nominees. They were observed to be qualified and fit for the appointment.

(B) CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION (CSC)

(i) **Mr. Joseph Oladoja Oladele JP, mni, FCAI** a native of Igbeti in Olorunsogo Local Government Council, Mr. Doja Oladele was born on 4th March, 1950. He is a Political Science graduate of the University of Ibadan. He is also an holder of a Post Graduate Diploma in Public Administration from the University of Ife now Obafemi Awolowo University

(OAU). He is a Member of the National Institute for Policy and Strategic Studies, Kuru, Jos.

He was a career Civil servant and an administrator per excellence. Mr Oladele worked as an Administrative Officer with the State Government from 1979 and rose through the ranks to the position of Director-General and Permanent Secretary in 1997. He worked as Permanent Secretary from 1997 to 2009 when he retired voluntarily

He is a highly respected Community Leader in Oke-Ogun, a Justice of Peace, and an Ambassador for Peace. He was found appointable as Full-Time Chairman.

(ii) **Mr. Festus Akinwale Ojebode** was born on 15th March, 1974, at Oyo in Oyo West Local Government, He obtained MBA from the University of Calabar 2006 and B.Sc. in Quantity Surveying in 2001 from Enugu State University of Science and Technology. He served as Project Quantity Surveyor in various Construction Companies between 2004 and April, 2015. He was appointed as Board member in the Oyo State Hospitals Management Board between July, 2014 – May, 2015. He is a diligent and accomplished professional. He was found appointable as a full-time member.

(iii) **Dr. Akeem Amodu** was born in Lagos on 27th January, 1968. He attended University of Ife where he obtained B. A., M.A and Ph.D (Philosophy) between 1987 and 2003. He joined the Service of University of Ife as Assitant lecturer 1993 -2002. He was a Senior Lecturer with the Lead City University, Ibadan (2005-till date). He twice served as Board member in the Oyo State Housing Corporation between July 2012 – December 2013 and July 2014 – May 28th 2015. He is a respecer of due process and an erudite scholar who has distinguished himself as a lecturer. He was found appointable as a Part-Time Member.

(iv) **Hon. Rafiu Oladeni Ojegoke** was born on 1st August, 1958, Hon. Oladeni Ojegoke is a native of Ayete in Ibarapa North Local Government Area, He is an HND holder in Building Technology, He is a renowned politician having served in vaious capacities as the Party Electoral Officer of Ifeloju Local government (1990-1993) Igboora, Board Member, Oyo State Housing Corporation (1992-1993, 2012-2013). He also served as Member, representing Ibarapa Central and North Federal Constituency in the Nigeria House of Representative

(1999–2003). He was found appointable as Part Time Member. Honourable members expressed satisfaction with the caliber of the nominees and were of the view that they will perform satisfactorily.

Motion made, “that the appointments of the nominees as Commissioners of Civil Service Commission (CSC) be confirmed – Hon G. J. Oyekola (Atiba).

Motion Seconded by Hon. M. A. Wahab (Oluyole)

8.0 THIRD READING OF OYO STATE ANIMAL FEED MILL BILL, 2017:

- (i) The report of the Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources on Oyo State Animal Feed Mill Bill, 2017 was presented by Hon. S. A. Olalere (Ido), Chairman

Motion made, “that the House do receive the report of the Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources as presented by the Chairman – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South West I) Majority Leader

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire) Minority Leader

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved accordingly in the affirmative

- (ii) Motion made, “that this Honourable House do constitute itself into Committee of the whole House to consider the report of the Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources on Oyo State Animal Feed Mill Bill, 2017” – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South West I) Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire) Minority Leader.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved accordingly in the affirmative.

IN THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE:

Long Title: Question, that Long Title Stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 1: Question, that Clause1 stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 2 : Amendment Proposed as follows:

- (i)a In “accredited officer” delete “accredited” before “officer” and insert “authorized”
- (i)b Insert “the Department of” before “livestock” and delete “designated by the Director of livestock Services”
- (ii)a In “animal feed” delete “mean” before “any” and Insert “includes”
b delete the “Consumption by livestock” after “for” and replace with “Livestock consumption”
- (iii)a In “animal feed mill delete “means” and replace with “include”
b expunge “and” after “process”
- (iv) “In Commissioner” insert “or any person charged for the time being with the responsibilities of the Ministry” after “Development”
- (v) In “Livestock” delete “mean” before “Cattle” and insert “includes”
- (vi) Insert Interpretation of “persons” “means natural or artificial person” before Interpretation of “State”

Question that Clause 2 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 3: Amendment proposed to Clause 3 thus, In Sub-Clause 3 delete “and shall hold office for a period of 3 years only” after “Secretary”

Question that Clause 3 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 4: Amendment proposed to Clause 4 as follows:

- (i) In Sub-Clause (a) delete “accepted” and insert “acceptable” after “Internationally”
 - (ii) In Sub-Clause (i) Insert a new (vi) thus “date of manufacture expiration of the product” and
 - (iii) Sub-Clause (i) become “(i)”
- Question that Clause 4 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 5: Amendment proposed as follows:

- (i) Insert a new Sub-Clause (i) as follows:

“As from the commencement of this Bill, operating Animal Feed Mill or marketing outlet without license in prohibited”

- (ii) Renumber former Sub-Clause 1 as (2)
- (iii) Expunge former Sub-Clause “2”
- (iv) In Sub-Clause 5 delete “to” after” “prescribed”
Question that Clause 5 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 6: Amendment proposed, delete “accredited” and replace with “authorized” wherever it appears.
Question that Clause 6 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 7: Amendment proposed as follows:

- (i)a delete “accredited” before “officer and replace with “authorized”
 - b delete “person” after “such” and replace with “producer or marketer”
 - c In line 5, insert “provided such producer or marketer shall be entitled to make representation in his defence” and number as Sub-Clause I
- (ii) Insert a new Sub-Clause 2 as follows: -
“Any person aggrieved with the action of the Director of Livestock Services In Sub-Section (i) of this Section may within 1 month, after such decision appeal in writing to the Commissioner giving reasons why the decision should have been otherwise”
- (iii).. Insert a new Sub-Clause 3 as follows: -
“The Commissioner shall within 3months of receipt of the his decision in writing to appellant”
Question that Clause 7 as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clause 8: Amendment Proposed as follows:

- a. delete former Sub-Clause (b) and replace with new Sub Clause (b) as follows: - “operates an animal feed mill or marketing outlet without license commits and offence and is liable on conviction to,
 - i a fine of N100,000 or imprisonment for a term of 1 month or both: and
 - ii having his premises sealed if he fails to obtain license within the stipulated time”

- ii(a) In Sub-Clause C, delete “accredited” and replace with “authorized” before “officer” in Sub-Clause C
- (b) delete “shall be” in line 4 and replace with “is”
- (c) In Sub Clause C, delete “a fine of N50,000 or to imprisonment of 6 months or both” and replace with “a fine of N150,000 or imprisonment for a term of 3 months or both.

Question that Clause 8 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 9: Question, that Clause 9 stand part of the Bill put and agreed to

Clause 10: Amendment proposed to side note Insert “Power to make” before Regulation”
Question, that Clause 10 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Clause 11: Amendment proposed, insert a new clause 11 as follows:
“Every feed mill producer or marketer in operation before the commencement of this Bill shall, within 6 months of the coming into force of this Bill obtain the requisite license”
Question, that Clause 11 as inserted stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

First Schedule: That first schedule stand part of the Bill
Question that first schedule stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

Second Schedule: Amendment proposed, delete former second schedule and replace with the following:
