5.0 **MATTER OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:**

Pursuant to Order VIII Rule (4) of the Standing Rules of Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. S.A. Olalere (Ido) raised A Matter of Urgent Public Importance titled: "Need to Urgently Repair Collapsed Bridge at Kuola-Alexandra-Adedayo Road, Apata in Ido Local Government Area".

By Mr. Speaker's order, the matter was referred to the Committee on Works and Transport to liaise with the Ministry of Works and Transport to take necessary action to ensure rehabilitation of the damaged bridge.

6.0 PERSONAL EXPLANATION:

Hon. M.O. Olagunju (Oyo West and Oyo East) drew the attention of the House to the demise of a seasoned broadcaster, poet, great actor, movie producer, director, Alagba Adebayo Faleti (26th December, 1921 – 23rd July, 2017). He was once Director, Mass Mobilization For Social and Economic Recovery (MAMSER), Oyo and Ondo States and former Chairman, Oyo State Council for Arts and Culture. He translated the National Anthem to Yoruba. The late icon hailed from Ido-Ide Compound, Oyo West Local Government. He attended the University of Dakar, Senegal and obtained a certificate of proficiency in French Language, he also graduated from the University of Ibadan with an honour degree in English Language. He received many awards locally and internationally including the National honour of Officer of the Order of the Niger (OON). His demise was glorious and ought to be celebrated by all and sundry. The House observed a minute silence in honour of the late icon.

By Mr. Speaker's order, all Honourable Members of the House were to pay a visit to the house of late Alagba Adebayo Faleti to commiserate and pray with the members of the family.

7.0 REMEDYING THE DECLINING PERFORMANCE OF STUDENTS IN OYO STATE IN PUBLIC EXAMINATIONS THROUGH IMPROVED RESOURCE INPUTS

Motion made "That this Honourable House appreciate the efforts of Executive Arm of Government towards revamping the Education Sector in the State and to be more proactive in remedying the declining performance of student in public examinations through provision of additional instructional materials and motivation of teachers in public schools" – Hon. (Mrs) Bimbo Olawumi Oladeji (Ogbomoso North) and Hon. Olusegun Olaniyi Olaleye (Ibadan North II)

Motion seconded by Hon. A.F. Adesina (Ibadan South-East I)

Title changed to: "Need to Encourage Better Performance of Students in Oyo State In Public Examination Through Improved Resource Inputs".

Question that the motion be taken put and agreed to

Resolved accordingly as follows; "that this Honourable House:

- A. “urge the Executive Arm of Government through the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology and other relevant Agencies to:
- (i) allocate and monitor funds meant for the provision of modern teaching and learning resource and facilities;
 - (ii) develop a programme to improve the quality and quantity of teachers in our schools through training and retraining of teachers;
 - (iii) monitor the performance of teachers in areas of instructional delivery to ensure that there is commensurate return on investments in terms of their performance;
 - (iv) activate and implement a plan to gradually phase out poor environmental conditions in schools spread across the State, replacing them with conditions that meet international standards. This can be done through provision of quality buildings, infrastructure, furniture and fittings in adequate quantity and quality landscape;
 - (v) ensure establishment of functional school libraries, stocked with relevant books and other instructional materials;
 - (vi) ensure proper implementation of educational policies in a way that will impact positively on the students and improve their performance in external examinations;
 - (vii) charge the Quality Assurance Directorate in the Ministry of Education to see to harmonized examination content with a view to ensuring improvement in the conduct of internal examinations and their results;
 - (viii) make the salary of teachers in secondary schools to be on first line charge;
 - (ix) give more attention to teachers/pupil in the rural areas in terms of monitoring and compensations; and
 - (x) have harmonized or mock examination taken by students in post primary and technical colleges before taking external examinations.
- B. Urge parents to pay particular attention to their children’s education by providing relevant text books and other learning materials to assist the children in their academic work at home and undertaking thorough inspection of their academic work; and

- C. Urge other stakeholders, that is Association of Old Students, Philanthropists, NGOs and well-meaning Nigerians to assist Government in the provision of relevant resource inputs in schools such as donation of blocks of classrooms, textbooks, laboratory equipment, furniture, scholarship for brilliant but indigent students and incentives for teachers among others;
