## 7.0 **MATTER OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:**

Pursuant to Order VIII Rule 4 of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. J. O. Ojo (Oriire), Minority Leader raised a Matter of Urgent Public Importance on “Need To Urgently Come To The Assistance Of Flood Victims At Olodo, Ibadan.”

Debate Arising:

**Resolved accordingly as follows** “That:

- (i) The Executive Arm of Government through Oyo State Emergency Management Agency and the Ministries of Environment and Ecology, Works and Transport, and Fire Services should initiate appropriate actions to bring succour to the victims of the flood disaster at Olodo in Ibadan, Oyo and other locations. They are also to take proactive measures to avert future occurrence, and
- (ii) The House Committee on Environment and Ecology should visit the flooded areas in Olodo and Old Ife Road, Ibadan, Oyo town and other areas in the State and report to the House”

## 8.0 **SECOND READING OF BILLS**

### (i) **COOPERATIVE SOCIETIES (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2017**

(ii) **OYO STATE PLANNING COMMISSION BILL, 2017**

Motion made and question proposed, **“That A Bill For A Law To Establish The Oyo State Planning Commission And To Provide For The Functions Of The Commission And Other Matters Connected There-With be read a Second Time”** – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South West I), Majority Leader.

Bill accordingly read a Second Time and referred to the Joint Committees on Public Accounts, Finance and Appropriation, Judiciary and Justice and Special Duties for further scrutiny and report to the house.

**9.0 COMMITTEE REPORT:**

The report of the Joint Committee on Security and Strategy and Special Duties that interfaced with the Chief Security Officer to the Governor, Special Adviser on Security Matters and other Stake holders on the need to beef up security outfit and strategies within the Oyo State Secretariat Complex and stem the menace of incessant theft, was presented by the Chairman, Hon. G. J. Oyekola (Atiba)

Motion made “that the House do receive the Report as presented by the Chairman for debate “– Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I) Majority Leader.

**Resolved accordingly as follows “that;**

- (i) The Executive Arm of Government through the Bureau of Establishments and Training be urged to employ more security staff, train and equip them to be well positioned to tackle security within the Secretariat,
- (ii) The Executive Arm of Government should consider the installation of Solar Panel to deal with the issue of erratic power supply to the Secretariat so as to discourage nefarious acts being carried out in the dark due to poor lighting
- (iii) The Executive Arm of Government should consider the use of tags for vehicle at the gates while the Ministries, Departments

and Agencies should be compelled to issue out identification tag to visitors;

- (iv) Government officials should also be compelled to put on their identity cards to distinguish them easily from visitors;
- (v) The Executive Arm of Government should establish a central Security Unit to coordinate Security Matters within the Ministries, Departments and Agencies; and
- (vi) That the Executive Arm of Government should consider the installation of CCTV in strategic places within the State Secretariat Complex.

**10. SUSPENSION OF ORDER IV (I):**

**11. URGENT NEED TO AVERT COMMUNAL CLASH BETWEEN COMMUNITIES AT THE BORDER OF OYO AND OSUN STATES IN SURULERE AND OGO-OLUWA LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS**

Motion made, “That this Honourable House critically consider the emerging molestation and attacks by communities in Osun State on the Communities in Surulere and Ogo-Oluwa Local Government Areas at the border which may brew into communal clash, and call on the Executive Arms of the two States to take decisive action (s) to stem the crisis and proffer lasting solution” – Hon. P. O. Oyetunji (Ogo-Oluwa/Surulere)

Motion seconded by Hon. G. J. Oyekola (Atiba)

Question that the motion be taken put and agreed to

**Resolved accordingly as follows:** “that,

- (i) the Executive Arm of Government should liaise with the Executive Arm of Government of Osun State to appeal to the communities at their border in Surulere and Ogo-Oluwa Local Government Areas to maintain peace, limit their activities to their boundary and desist from trespassing, attacking or

- forcefully claiming properties that rightly belong to communities in Oyo State,
- (ii) the matter be referred to the Oyo State Technical Committee on Boundary and Communal Dispute to look into the issue and give the House feedback; and
  - (iii) that the Joint Committees on Lands, Housing, and Survey and Special Duties to meet with Oyo State Technical Committee on State Boundary and Communal Disputes with a view to investigating the matter, proffer solution and report to the House.
