## **7.0 SCREENING OF A NOMINEE AS A MEMBER OF STATE JUDICIAL SERVICE COMMISSION**

Barrister Ajayi Ayoola Adeleke appeared before the House for screening as a Member of the State Judicial Service Commission. He was put on oath and thereafter presented his resume.

**Barrister Ajayi Ayoola Adeleke** was born on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 1965. He hails from Epe Local Governmet Council of Lagos State. He graduated with a Bachelor of Law (Honours) degree in 1991. He had been a practicing lawyer since graduation.

## **8.0 THIRD READING OF PRIVATE VETERINARY PREMISES AND VETERINARY ESTABLISHMENT (REGULATORY) BILL, 2017**

(ii) In “Disease” insert “Cap.9” after “law” in line 3,

(iii) insert “Permanent Secretary” means the Administrative Head of the Ministry of Agriculture, Natural Resources and Rural Development” before interpretation of “Person”.

(iv) In “Veterinary establishments”,

(a) In line 2 delete “hotel” and replace with “hostel”

(b) In line 3, delete ‘animal feeds production and sales depots”.

Question that Clause 2 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

**Clause 9:** Question, that Clause 9 stand part of the Bill put and agreed to

**Clause 10:** Amendment proposed that former Sub-clause (Ic) be deleted and replaced with “Ensure that the conduct of and mode of operation and the handling of animals in the Private Veterinary Premises and Veterinary Establishment are in accordance with the guidelines and veterinary ethics prescribed by the Veterinary Councils of Nigeria”.

Question, that Clause 10 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

**Clause 11:** Amendment proposed as follows:

- (i) In Sub-clause 1, delete “Registration and” before “Regulation”.
- (ii) In Sub-clause 2a delete “Commissioner” and replace with “Permanent Secretary”.
- (iii) Insert a new Sub-clause 3 as follow:
  - 3(a) “the Committee shall meet at least once a quarter and such meeting shall be held at such place and time and on such days as the Chairman may determine”.
  - ()” the Chairman shall preside at every meeting of the Committee at which he is present, and *if he is* absent the members present at the meeting shall elect one of their members to preside thereat”.
  - (c) “the Chairman or the member presiding at a meeting of the Committee in his absence shall not have a vote except in event of an equality of votes, a casting vote”.
  - (d) “the quorum of the Committee shall be four including the Chairman or member presiding at a meeting in the absence of the Chairman”.
  - (e) “the validity of any proceeding of the Committee shall not be affected by any vacancy among the members or any defect in the appointment of a member”
- (iv) insert a new Sub-clause (4) as follows: -

“Members of the Committee shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as the Governor may approve” and
- (v) insert a new Sub-Clause (5) as follows: -

“For non-ex-officio person(s), appointed pursuant to Section (11) (2) of this Bill shall hold Office for a period not more than five (5) years and may be eligible for reappointment for one more term only”.

By unanimous consent, the proposed amendment to Clause 11 Sub-clause (5) was expunged.

Question, that Clause 11 as amended stand part of the Bill put and agreed to.

the Executive Arm of the State Government should:

- (i) formulate and enforce concrete policies/guidelines which will encourage all public schools’ teachers, policy makers, serving politicians and stakeholders to enroll at least a child or ward in Government Schools in order to facilitate education advancement of the State; and
- (ii) through the Ministry of Education, Science and Tehnology, the State Unviersal Basic Education Board (SUBEB) and Teaching Service Commission (TESCOM) seek the approval of His Excellency to give awards and prizes to the best teacher in the State on annual basis. This is to sustain the financial reward given to subject teachers whose students are outstanding in examinations conducted by external examination bodies e.g. West Africa Examination Council (WAEC).

#### **10.0 NEED FOR URGENT GOVERNMENT ATTENTION ON DILAPIDATED AND ABANDONED BUILDINGS IN OYO STATE WHICH HAVE BECOME HIDE OUTS FOR CRIMINALS AND CONSTITUTE SECURITY THREATS**

Motion made, “that this Honourable House urge the Executive Arm of Government and other Stakeholders to formulate and implement a plan of action and profer the way forward on indigenous and dilapidated buildings that constitute environmental and security threats to their occupiers and neighbours across the State” – Hon.
