Motion made, "that, this Honourable House note that Guidance and Counseling is integral to educational development of students to help them become productive and useful citizens and therefore appeal to School Proprietors (government and private) to engage the services of Professional Guidance Counsellors and provide them with working tools for effective performance" - Hon. - (a) that the Executive Arm of Government through the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology, Teaching Service Commission (TECOM) and State Universal Basic Education Board be urged to:
  - (i) Engage the Services of suitably qualified career Guidance Counsellors in all Junior and Senior Secondary Schools in Oyo State;
  - (ii) Establish and equip Counselling Clinics, Career Resource Centres and Information Centres across the State;
- (b) Urge the Association of Private Schools Proprietors in the State to ensure that members of the Association engage the services of suitably qualified career Guidance Counsellors in private Secondary Schools in the State; and
- (c) That the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology, Teaching Service Commission, State Universal Basic Education Board and three (03) representative of National Association of Private School Proprietors in the State be invited to a meeting with the Committee on Education, Science and Technology.

**9.0 URGENT NEED TO REPAIR THE BAD PORTION OF MONIYA – ISEYIN ROAD SO AS NOT TO HINDER MOVEMENT OF AGRICULTURAL GOODS FROM OKE –OGUN AREA”**

Motion made,” that this Honourable House note with concern high rate at which erosion is eating deep and damaging the road from Moniya to Iseyin with a view to calling on the relevant Government Ministry and Agency to urgently rehabilitate the road for easy transportation and economic development of the State”. - (ii) the Committee on Works and Transport should collate all the damaged roads across the State and liaise with the Ministry of Works and Transport and Oyo State Road Maintenance Agency with a view to rehabilitating the roads. The Committee should report to the House in two weeks.
