#### **7.0 MATTERS OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:**

- (i) Motion made, “that Order VIII Rule 4 of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly be suspended to enable the House take more than one Matter of Urgent Public Importance and deliberate on them this day” – Hon. S.O. Ajanaku(Ibadan South-West II), Chairman, Parliamentary Council.

- (ii) Pursuant to Order VIII Rule (4) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba) raised A Matter of Urgent Public Importance titled “Need to Urgently call on the Ministry of Education to Release the Result of 2017 Common Entrance Examination and Plalcement into Junior Secondary School For 2017/2018 Session”

By leave of the House and in view of the fact that the Common Entrance Examination Result had been released by the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology, the matter was noted to have been overtaken by events. The matter was referred to the Committee on Education, Science and Technology for more interractions with the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology.

- (iii) Pursuant to Order VIII Rule (4) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. A.F. Adesina (Ibadan South-East I) raised A

Matter of Urgent Public Importance titled “The Relegation of Shooting Stars Sports Club: Matter Arising”

By Mr. Speaker’s Order, the matter was referred to the Committee on Youth and Sports to invite the under-listed to shed more light on the Club’s activities in the last four (4) years and report to the House:

- (i) The entire Management of Shooting Stars to be led by the General Manager;

- (v) Players’ representative;
- (vi) Staff of Shooting Stars Sports Club;
- (vii) Relevant Stakeholders including interested ex-players; and
- (viii) Representative of Sport Writers Association in Oyo State and other interested Public Official.

#### **8.0 PERSONAL EXPLANATIONS:**

- (i) Hon. P.O. Oyetunji (Ogo Oluwa/Surulere) informed the House that the day commemorated the birthday of Hon. G. J. Oyekola (Atiba) LP, Party Whip.

He presented a tribute of the celebrant and laid emphasis on his achievements politically at the community level, domestically and also as a religious leader. He also eulogized him on his positive contributions to the 8<sup>th</sup> Oyo State House of Assembly. The celebrant was encouraged to do more to serve humanity. The Report of a Capacity Building Training Programme organized by KONRAD ADENEUR STIFTUNG (KAS) for Plateau, Cross Rivers, Ogun, Oyo, Enugu, Abia and Taraba States Houses of Assembly from 22<sup>nd</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 at Obudu Rouch, Cross River State, (the Conference tagged

“Influence of Parliaments on Development and State Policies”) was presented by Hon. J. A. Olaleru (Kajola), Deputy Chief Whip.

Motion made “that the the Conference Report be adopted for debate” – Hon. K. H. Subair (Ibadan South–West I) Majority Leader.

**Resolved accordingly as follows “that;**

A that this Honourable House:

- (i) facilitate collaborative efforts, regional harmony and cooperation among the States in the South-West with a view to achieving common goal in the area of development and diversification of economy e.g. Agriculture and Independent Power generation;
- (ii) charge its various Committees to engage in oversight functions so as to monitor the implementation and performances of MDAs before the general budget defense session takes place;
- (iii) work towards having a retreat with the Executive on yearly basis before the compilation of each year’s budget to address conflicting areas in order to harmonize them before budget is presented;
- (iv) facilitate participatory budgeting in Oyo State where members of the Public, Traditional rulers and Community leaders e.t.c. are involved in the preparation of budget so as to take cognizance of the areas of priorities and interest;
- (v) further embrace the collaboration of KAS and National Orientation Agency in Organizing Town Hall meeting for the electorates in their various constituencies.

B that the Executive Arm of Oyo State Government should;

- (i) strengthen its security outfit i.e Operation “Burst” with more fund for their operation and other logistics to enable them function well and effectively;
- (ii) create enabling environment to do business by ensuring we have clean and safe environment free of refuse and waste on our roads;

- (iii) provide and revive skill acquisition\vocational centres across the State where unemployed youths can learn and gain knowledge to become employers of labour i.e. SMES;
- (iv) Collaborate with Traditional Rulers, Community leaders, Land Lord associations for Community developmental projects across the State;
- (v) Urge the National Assembly to expedite action towards the amendment of some Sections of the Nigeria Constitution of 1999 especially Financial Autonomy for State Houses of Assembly could be attained;
- (vi) Improve and develop the various tourists centres in the State to boost revenue generation.

#### **10.0 NEED FOR PRESERVATION AND PROMOTION OF THE CULTURAL ATTRIBUTES OF THE PEOPLE OF OYO STATE**

Motion made “That this Honourable House critically examine Yoruba culture as the beliefs, customs, language, cuisine, social habits, music and arts which is expected to be passed down from generation to generation and the influence of Western civilization and globalization that is fast eroding its values with a view to urging the Executive to take proactive actions at revamping and preserving the rich Yoruba culture” – Hon. M.O. Olagunju (Oyo East/West).

Motion seconded by Hon. G. J. Oyekola (Atiba).

Question that the Motion be taken put and agreed to.

**Resolved accordingly as follows** “that the

A Executive Arm of Government be urged to:

- (i) immediately revive and strengthen the Oyo State Council for Arts and Culture for the purpose of carrying out the huge task of preserving and promoting many aspects of our dying culture;
- (ii) create a special fund for the purpose of having steady flow of resources in the quest to re-position the cultural heritage of the people of Oyo State;
- (iii) set about the task of immediate collation of documentary and audio/visual materials that will preserve music, drum beats, folk tales, ewi, proverbs, ijala, panegyrics and other genres or variants of cultural identities including handy vocations;

- (iv) involve Traditional Rulers in the nooks and crannies of Oyo State, as Custodians and repository of Cultural value in the task of preserving and promoting our Cultural Heritage.
  - (v) support the revival and promotion of cultural events in all registered schools in Oyo State and even organize periodic State-wide cultural competitions among cultural troupes and/or students;
  - (vi) promote and sustain the Oyo State Cultural troupe for the purpose of encouraging enthusiasm and purposeful participation in cultural engagement locally and internationally; and
  - (vii) establish a museum and compendium to be a custodian of Cultural Practices, Arts and Heritage of the Yoruba people.
  - (viii) encourage extra-curricula activities in all Primary, Secondary and Tertiary Institutions in the State to include Cultural Societies and organization of debates in Yoruba language;
- B That the House choose a day in a month when all Hon. Members will put on Aso-Ofi attire at Plenary Session.
