5.0 ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Mr. Speaker announced that the Committee on Youth and Sports would meet with the Commissioner and the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Youth and Sports and Chairman, the General Manager and Technical Crew of the Shooting Stars Football Club (3SC) after the Plenary Sitting this day.

6.0 DIRECTIVES:

Mr. Speaker directed all Committees handling Bills and other legislative assignments to fast track action on these Bills and report back to the House to facilitate immediate consideration at Plenary Sitting.

7.0 MATTERS OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:

Pursuant to Order VIII Rule (4) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. Joshua Oyebamiji (Akinyele I), raised a Matter of Urgent Public Importance titled: "Need To Beef Up Security At Pade School Of Science Because Of The Recent Armed Robbery Attack On Students And Staffs Of The School"

Motion made that, in view of the importance of the matter which bordered on security of the lives and properties of the Students and Staffs of the School, Order VIII Rule 4 (3) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly be suspended to allow the House deliberate on the matter – Hon. O.S. Akande (Ogbomosho South).

Motion seconded by Hon. A.F. Adesina (Ibadan South-East I).

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved accordingly in the affirmative.

Debate Arising.

By leave of the House, the Matter was referred to Committees on Security and Strategy and Education, Science and Technology to liaise with all Stakeholders on the causes and solution to the issue.

8.0 PERSONAL EXPLANATION:

Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba) LP Party Whip eulogized Hon. (Mrs.)Wumi Oladeji (Ogbomosho North) who celebrated her birthday on the 1st of October, 2017.

In facilitation with her, he presented her tribute and laid emphasis on her achievements politically at the community level and domestically as a woman. It was noted that she sponsored several motions at Plenary,

actively chaired Committee on Women Affairs and organized empowerment programme for her constituents. She was described as blunt and passionate. The House wished her long life in good health and more or God's blessing.

9.0 NEED FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF OYO STATE ACCIDENT RESCUE MANAGEMENT UNITS

Motion made, "that this Honourable House deliberate on deplorable state of most of the roads which are major cause of accidents and non-availability of quick response units for the accident victims which sometimes leads to preventable death and implore the Executive Arm of Government to Establish Accident Rescue Management Units and other logistics to safe lives of accident victims" – Hon. (Mrs.) B.O. Oladeji (Ogbomoso North).

Motion seconded by Hon. J Oyebamiji (Akinyele I).

Question that the Motion be taken put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

Question put and agreed to.

Resolved accordingly as follows "that the Executive Government should:

- (i) Establish the Oyo State Accident Rescue Management Unit, an outfit that will see to the needs of victims of road accidents;
- (ii) Fund and equip the Unit with Sophisticated medical equipments and professional health workers who are specialists in handling emergency cases;
- (iii) Locate Centres of the Unit on roads leading to major cities and border towns in the State;
- (iv) Ensure that the Centres have functional and well equipped ambulances that will treat and transport accident victims from accident scenes to nearby health facilities and hospitals;
- (v) Provide towing vehicles to evacuate traffic wreckages from the scene of road accidents in order to reduce and eradicate road obstruction and traffic congestion on the scene of road accidents;
- (vi) That the prayers in (i) – (v) above be granted and extended to rural areas on the long run;
- (vii) Allocate dedicated lines through which members of the public can contact staffers of the Unit for prompt and immediate response during emergency situations; and
- (viii) That Commissioner and Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Health and the Permanent Secretary, Hospitals Management Board be invited to a meeting with Committee on Health on Tuesday, 17th October, 2017 to brief the Committee on the state of Emergency Rescue Ambulances procured during the first tenure of His

Excellency, Senator Abiola Ajimobi and the viability of establishment of Oyo State Accident Rescue Agency.

10.0 NEED TO RESUSCITATE AND COMPLETE THE ABANDONED ILERO WATER SCHEME TO ALLEVIATE THE SUFFERING OF THE COMMUNITY FROM SHORTAGE OF POTABLE WATER

Motion made, “that this Honourable House critically examine the inaccessibility of potable water at Ilero because the contractors abandoned the construction and expansion of the water scheme after collecting money with a view to calling on the relevant Government Departments to come and explain the causes and solution to the problem” - Hon. J. A. Olaleru (Kajola), Deputy Chief Whip.

Motion seconded by Hon. O.S. Akande (Ogbomoso South).

Question that the Motion be taken put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

By leave of the House, the motion was referred to Committee on Water Resources for investigation and extend to other the project awarded in respect of Water Scheme across the State and report to the House.
