Mr. Speaker announced that Committee on Commerce and Cooperative will meet immediately after the Plenary Sitting.

5.0 **MATTERS OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE:**

Pursuant to Order VIII Rule (4) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly, Hon. K.H. Subair (Ibadan South-West I), raised a Matter of Urgent Public Importance titled "Worrisome Public Disturbance: Thuggery, Public Brawl and Other Violent Crimes Around Isala-Osi, Iyana Asuni, Gidarami, Born Photo and Gege Area in Ibadan South West Local Government".

He brought to the notice of the House, how youth carnival meant for socialization turned awry on Sunday, 22nd October, 2017 in his Constituency. He informed the House that some hoodlums hijacked the carnival and turned it to public brawl. The whole of Isale osi, Iyana Asuni, Gidarami, Born Photo and Gege area became scene of thuggery, looting, stealing, battering, arson and other violent crimes. The thugs unleashed terror on innocent citizens in the area. He pleaded that the

House take measure towards addressing the situation and possibly find a long term solution to prevent violent crimes in the area.

Motion made, “that, in view of the importance of the Matter which bordered on security of lives and properties of the citizenry, Order VIII Rule 4 (3) of the Standing Rules of the Oyo State House of Assembly be suspended to allow the House deliberate on the matter” – Hon. O.S. Akande (Ogbomoso South).

Motion seconded by Hon. A.A. Adeleke (Iseyin/Itesiwaju).

Question put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

By leave of the House, the Committee on Security and Strategy was mandated to look into the matter and report to the House.

6.0 PERSONAL EXPLANATION:

Hon. A.A. Ige (Ibadan South-East II) drew the attention of the House to the demise of the former Majority Leader of this notable House in the 3rd Assembly, Alh. Hon. Kelani Kunle Adisa who passed on at the early hours of Monday, 23rd October, 2017 at the University College Hospital, Ibadan. (1942 – 2017).

Late Hon. Kelani attended IMG Primary School, Oloro, Ibadan and Mayflower Secondary School, Ikenne for his elementary and secondary education respectively. He also attended the Nigeria Institute of Oceanography and the Marine Institute at Federal Fisheries School, Lagos from 10th February, 1981 – 10th September, 1983.

He joined the Civil Service of Oyo State at the Fishery Division of the Ministry of Agriculture, Natural Resources and Rural integration from 1962 to 1988. He joined partisan politics after his retirement and was elected as Honourable Member representing Ibadan South East II under the platform of the defunct (SDP), 1991 – 1993. He was also the Chairman of defunct DPM. He later served as Special Adviser on Legislative Matters to former Governor Rasidi Ladoja from 2003 – 2007. Late Alh. Hon. Adisa Kelani was survived by a wife and children.

The House observed a minute silence in honour of the late political icon. By leave of the House, the Clerk of the House was directed to write a letter of condolence to the family of the late Honourable Member.

2. Hon. G.J. Oyekola (Atiba) drew the attention of the House to the birthday celebrations of two Honourable Members, namely Hon. A.A. Oladipo (Ibadan North-West) on (19/10/17) and Hon. R.A. Jimoh (Ibarapa North/Central) (06/10/17). The duo clocked 57 and 53 years respectively.

Hon. A.A. Oladipo was eulogized for his political performances as two term honourable member of the Assembly and a grass root politician who always put his people's interest first.

Hon. (Alhaji) R.A. Jimoh was also described as a pious moslem, a seasoned politician who has contributed positively to the success of this august Assembly.

7.0 PASSIONATE APPEAL TO STATE JOINT LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACCOUNT ALLOCATION COMMITTEE (JAAC) TO PRIORITIZE THE PAYMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT STAFF SALARY

Motion made "that this Honourable House take cognizance of the dwindling allocation of funds from the Federation Accounts to both the State and Local Governments Councils and its toll on the funding of the Local Government Councils by the State Joint Local Government Accounts Allocation Committee with a view to urging the Committee to prioritize the payment of salary of staff of the Local Government Councils" – Hon. W.A. Akinmoyede (Lagelu), Chief Whip.

Motion seconded by Hon. L.O. Balogun (Oorelope).

Question that the Motion be taken put and agreed to.

Debate Arising.

By leave of the House, the motion was referred to the Committee on Local Government, Chieftaincy Matters and State Honours to meet with the Stakeholders on the matter and report to the House.

8.0 COMMITTEE REPORT

The Report of Committee on Health on her interaction with the Ministry of Health on measures taken to prevent the outbreak of Monkey-Pox in Oyo State was presented by the Chairman Hon. S.A. Okunlola (Iwajowa).

Motion made "that the House do receive the Report as presented by the Chairman for debate" – Hon. A.O. Oyatokun (Afijio), Deputy Majority Leader.

Motion seconded by Hon. A.F. Adesina (Ibadan South-East I), Accord.

Debate Arising.

Question put and agreed to.

The House consequently resolved as follows, that;

- (i) the Ministry of Health be commended for rising up to the occasion by taking some proactive action such as providing personal protective equipment to some health institutions and educating disease surveillance officers on preventive measures;
- (ii) the Executive Arm of Government be enjoined to give necessary financial and logistic support to the Ministry of Health on its efforts to combat any epidemic prone disease in the State;

- (iii) the Ministry of Health should sustain its collaborative efforts with relevant agencies and organisations to ensure the containment and abatement of monkey pox disease in the State;
- (iv) the Ministry of Health should intensify efforts on its sensitization programme to educate and enlighten members of the public more on the causes, prevention and symptoms of monkey pox and steps to be taken when contacted with the virus or infected persons; and
- (v) members of the public be implored to observe hygienic culture in all their activities especially keeping their environment tidy and also regular washing of hands.
